Roaring River State Park ready for Opening Day

Missouri State Parks has designated 2013 the "Year of the Trout," a concept many local resident celebrate every year. For Cassville residents March 1st is a sacred holiday backed by tradition.

Roaring River State Park, along with local businesses, are gearing up for Friday's Trout Day.

More than 2,300 anglers are expected to stand elbow to elbow as they cast their fishing lines into Roaring River signaling the opening of trout season.

Firing the gun this year is longtime RRSP volunteer Ron Moffet. Moffet has been a volunteer at the Park since 1985. The gun will be fired at 6:30 a.m.

"Ron Moffet will have the honor of firing the gun to start the season and receiving the honorary first tag," stated RRSP superintendent Dusty Reid.

"Ron has been volunteering at Roaring River State Park since 1985, and was present at some of the very first Kid's Fishing Days.

"Ron is very involved in Kid's Fishing programs and works with children not only at Kids Fishing Day but during fishing clinics at Roaring River throughout the year. He is active in teaching children how to clean and cook fish as well.

"He also donates fishing equipment and volunteers many hours keeping MDC loaner poles in operating condition," Reid said.

According to KY3 weather reports, the high on Friday is to top out at 34 degrees. For those wishing to warm up, the Roaring River Restaurant will open at 7:00 a.m. on March 1st and will close at 7:00 p.m.

Those hitting the riverbank early can warm up with complimentary coffee and coffee mugs from the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce. Volunteers will hand out coffee beginning at 5:00 a.m. to the first 750 people.

The Chamber will also award Cassville Cash to individuals with the largest fish in the men, women and children's divisions.

Fishing tags will be available at the Park Store, which will open at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 28th, and will be open all night.

Man arrested for burglary of Aurora Fire Department building

State Trooper Travis Hilburn recovered a stolen four-wheeler on Highway VV at the residence of Dennis Schmidt on Friday, February 15th.

Sponsored by FCCLA, the program provides an opportunity for junior and senior high school students to spend a day with their state representative, senator or other public official at the State Capitol. The students

observe hearings, meetings and other public duties.

Skylar was given the opportunity to shadow newly elected Representative Scott Fitzpatrick. Representative Fitzpatrick took Skylar on a personal tour of the Capital Building which included the famous "Whisper Room" and the beautiful view from the top of the dome. The Representative introduced Skylar as a special guest on the floor of the House, and showed her the behind the scenes process of how a bill becomes law.

When asked about her

shadowing experience, Skylar said, "In school we read about how a bill becomes a law in government class, but I was given the opportunity to experience it first-hand. There are many experiences from my day at the State Capital that I will soon not forget.

"I was fortunate to be paired with Representative Fitzpatrick for my shadowing experience. He is a wonderful person to spend time with and a former CHS graduate. He does a wonderful job in Jefferson City and represents our community well."

The Legislative Shadowing Project allows students to connect their interests in law, public service, civic issues and the political process with their education. The event is designed to help students develop a better understanding of the political process and its impact on citizens.

Seligman mayor resigns

During the regular monthly meeting of Seligman's City Council held on February 13th, Mayor Jason Raucstadt presented the Council with his resignation of office; and as the City's maintenance supervisor.

According to meeting minutes, Alderman Eric Freeman called the Council meeting to order at 6:31 p.m. and the Council went into closed session. Mayor Raucstadt's time of arrival was documented at 6:52 p.m. and handed in his resignation just two minuets after his arrival.

According to City Clerk Brian Nichols, Raucstadt did not give a reason for his resignation, just the parting words, "I hope you can run this City better than I did."

During closed session, Alderman Gerald Harling made the motion to pay out all sick, personal and vacation time to Jason Raucstadt upon the return of City property. Alderman Kelly Payne second the motion with aldermen Eric Freeman and Danny Hendrix also voting in favor of the motion.

Alderman Harling also made a motion to change the maintenance supervisor position to salary on the basis of 40 hours per week at a rate of \$16 per hour. Also in the motion, Harling asked to create a full time city administrator position at the rate of \$15.50 per hour and to change the police chief position to salary based on 45 hours per week and \$15.50 per hour. The motion was second by Alderman Kelly Payne with all other voting in favor of the motion.

Following the twenty minute closed session meeting the Council voted to accept the mayor's resignation.

Mayor Pro Tem Eric Freeman assumed the role as mayor until another candidate can be appointed for the duration of the term set to expire April 2nd, 2013.

Melton speaks to Shell Knob Lions Club

Monday evening the Shell Knob Lion's Club welcomed former Missouri Senator Emory Melton as their program speaker at the Shell Knob/Viola Community building. As a lawyer and noted historian, Melton spoke about the families that settled in the Shell Knob and Viola area after the settlement of the Henry Schell family in 1835, for whom Shell Knob was named.

His speech was coupled with several humorous stories about the interactions of these families.

Emory shared, "Having married into the Sanders family that settled on the White River before the Civil War, my wife quickly taught me that they were always right in their ideas. She was a school teacher and taught in the local schools for a number of years."

He elaborated on the history of the number of numerous small school districts in Barry and Stone County before the 50's. This consolidation affected the makeup of smaller towns, and in some instances was a disaster to the economy and population of the 115 small rural districts in Barry County. He received a standing ovation

for his presentation and members were delighted to have him share his memories and knowledge.

New members inducted into the Shell Knob Lion's Club were Troy Clayton and Patricia Thornton. They were given the traditional "Lion's Roar" as acceptance.

Drought assistance available for Stone and Barry County

Farmers and ranchers in Barry and Stone counties are now entitled to receive federal assistance due to the severe drought last summer.

Hickory and Lawrence counties were designated as "primary natural disaster areas," however, farmers and ranchers in the following counties are eligible for assistance because they are contiguous to those counties. In addition to Barry and Stone counties, Christian, Greene, Polk, Benton, Dade, Jasper, St. Clair, Camden, Dallas and Newton counties are included in the declaration.

All counties listed above were designated natural disaster areas Feb. 20, 2013, and ranchers affected by making all qualified farm operators in the designated areas eligible for low interest emergency (EM) loans from USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibility requirements are met. Farmers in eligible counties have eight months from the date of the declaration to apply for loans to help cover part of their actual losses. FSA will consider each loan application on its own merits, taking into account the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.




Math competitors qualify for Regionals



Standing Up for Our Second Amendment Right

The right to keep and bear arms is one of the most important fundamental freedoms guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution because it guarantees that people have the right to protect themselves, their property and their families. During my time in the Missouri House of Representatives and Missouri Senate, I have fought to preserve the Second Amendment rights of Missourians against those who seek to take away this precious constitutional freedom. Below, I will highlight a few of the measures the Legislature may be considering this session related to firearms or

the Second Amendment. Some of you may have read about or heard about HB 545 which would make it a class C felony to manufacture, import, possess, purchase, sell, or transfer any assault weapon or large capacity magazine. Frankly speaking, this bill is not going anywhere. It was introduced by a minority party member from

St. Louis in the Missouri House of Representatives. The political make-up of the House notwithstanding, this bill shouldn't go anywhere. House Bill 545 is a serious overstep and an outright attack on the Second Amendment rights of Missourians. Should this bill be introduced in the Senate or, by some chance, advance to the Senate from the House, I will work to defeat it.

Another measure, Senate Bill 124 was introduced by a minority member of the Senate and would create the crimes of negligent storage of a firearm and failure to notify a school of firearm ownership. Let me also say, in no uncertain terms, that I am 100% opposed to this legislation and will work to defeat it if it reaches the full Senate for consideration. To require parents to register gun ownership with a school is a dangerous intrusion into private citizens' lives and would do nothing to protect our children.

We are all shocked and saddened by the terrible tragedy that occurred in Connecticut last December.

It was an act of immeasurable violence and evil. However, we must consider if recent proposals made both at the state and federal level would actually have prevented this tragedy or would address the underlying problems that caused the shooting. Rather than penalizing law-abiding, responsible gun owners, we should be looking at mental health issues and treatment as priorities in our fight against senseless violent acts. Our Constitutional rights were secured and maintained with great sacrifice and we should be careful to not undo the work of our Founding Fathers with an emotional reaction that does not fix the problem.

I am open to discussing the role of firearms in society. However, I do not believe limiting our Second Amendment rights is the proper place to start that conversation.

I have worked hard during my time as a public servant to protect the right to keep and bear arms guaranteed to us by both the Federal and State Constitutions and continue to defend this Constitutional important right. I am grateful for the opportunity to speak for the people of the 29th District and work for sensible public policy that reflects our shared

Missouri law requires any person born after January 1, 1984, to carry a boating safety certification card along with a picture ID anytime they operate a vessel, which includes personal watercraft, on Missouri lakes.

Participants must be present to satisfy requirements to obtain a boating safety card. There is no fee for the course, but students are required to preregister online as class sizes are limited.

started out relatively routinely in Jefferson City. We were cut short in our efforts to get some legislation passed as we adjourned on Wednesday evening instead of Thursday due to the impending winter storm. While it was a short week, some things did get accomplished. The only bill that was actually 3rd read and passed out of the House and sent to the Senate, was a "tax amnesty" bill. When a bill goes to the house floor, it has to undergo a two day process, at minimum. The first day, it is "perfected". This is the day the majority of the debate is heard on the bill, and it is also when amendments are added to shape the bill into what it will become before it heads to the Senate. The second day, it is 3rd read. This is the day that the final bit of debate is heard and there is actually a roll call vote on the bill, which is when I press the button at my desk on the floor to cast my vote as "yes", "no", or "present".

While "tax amnesty" was the only bill that was 3rd read this past week, we did perfect two other bills. One bill related to the consolidation of resources at the University of Missouri Extension Offices, and the other related to TIFs for disaster areas, which would help devastated cities, such as Joplin, rebuild after a storm in which at least 25% of their taxable property is destroyed in a disaster. I will be studying the intricacies of these bills prior to their 3rd reading on the week of the 25th of February.

In the event the Senate passes the tax amnesty bill, the Governor will sign it. The reason I am so confident in that prediction is that the Governor included the revenue that the amnesty policy is expected to generate in his budget recommendations. If you are not familiar with tax amnesty, it is a temporary policy that will allow citizens who are past due on their taxes to make a onetime payment on those taxes to catch up with the state without being required to pay penalties and interest. It is estimated that this will result in the collection of between \$50 and \$75 million dollars for the upcoming fiscal year. When the bill hit the House floor there were a couple of amendments added to tighten it up. I understand very well that sometimes people and businesses have cash flow difficulties and are unable to pay their taxes in a timely manner. That being said, we added an amendment to


the bill that would make a taxpayer ineligible for any future amnesty programs for the same type of tax if they take part in this one. This will keep folks from abusing amnesty opportunities. In addition, if a taxpayer who takes advantage of the amnesty program falls behind on their taxes again at any point in the following eight years, the penalties that were owed at the time when amnesty was granted will be reapplied. I think this is a well thought out piece of legislation, and I supported

I have continued to several emails receive regarding HB 545, which was a very blatant attack on gun rights. This Republican legislature will not let anything like that pass. It just will not happen. I will fight any proposal that attempts to usurp our Constitution. That promise does not stop at the 2nd amendment.

As the legislature has picked up speed, and my previous report was very lengthy, I am going to be reporting a little more frequently, so as to not overload my readers with information, and to keep it coming in reasonable doses. This last week of February will be a busy one, as we will have to make up for lost time from missing this past Thursday.
