For participants in Barry County’s Drug Court program, community service is an integral part of their repaying their debt to society. However, it isn’t as often that their community service allows them to use their work as a creative outlet.

Ashton Scott, a probation and parole officer for the Barry County Drug Court, suggested a community-specific project which was helpful to an area community as well as the participants in Drug Court. For an act of community service, they got together and did an overhaul of the City of Exeter’s Christmas lights and decorations to make sure they were in top shape before Christmas time.

Scott said, “We just really wanted to give back to the community, and we noticed the city was needing it.” In all, the volunteers repainted, replaced lights and put new

Roaring River State Park attendance up 10 percent

Local state parks at Roaring River and Table Rock Lake had a significant increase in attendance this year, adding to the record-breaking 20 million visitors that enjoyed Missouri State Parks this year.

Roaring River’s attendance was up 10 percent this year, likely due to the opening of the renovated

CCC Lodge on May 6. Table Rock State Park was up 18 percent. November’s General Election ballot had the Missouri Parks, Soils and Water sales tax renewal pass with the highest margin since its inception. Missouri had 80 percent of voters approve the measure, ensuring funding to parks for the next ten years.

In 2009, Governor Jay Nixon set a goal to have attendance at Missouri State Parks hit 20 million. This year was the first time the goal was met. Nixon’s initiative was to reverse the decline in state park attendance over the ten years prior to 2009. Nixon also encouraged park improvements to aid in attaining the goal.

“Missourians recognize the natural treasures we have in our state parks, and again supported the renewal of the Parks, Soil and Water sales tax with its highest margin ever just last month as 80 percent of voters approved renewal,” Gov. Nixon said. “In turn, we’ve not only invested mil-

Monett woman arrested for alleged meth dealing

A Monett woman was arrested after allegedly throwing drugs out of her car during a traffic stop. Justine McCaffrey, 29, of Monett, was charged with possession of a controlled substance, distribution of a controlled substance and unlawful use of drug paraphernalia.

According to the affidavits of probable cause by the Barry County Sheriff's Department, McCaffrey was pulled over for failing to maintain her lane of travel and failure to use a turn signal on Tuesday, December 20, on Highway C in Purdy. When Deputy Lombard approached the vehicle, he observed McCaffrey throw items out of the passenger window.

Deputy Lombard reported that McCaffrey had thrown three clear plastic bags, a digital scale, six Clonazepam pills and a bag of 15.07 grams of crystal substance that field-tested positive for methamphetamine. When questioned, McCaffrey allegedly admitted she was transporting the methamphetamine to someone else for distribution.

McCaffrey is currently being held in the Barry County Jail in lieu of a \$40,000 bond.

Moore was driving a 2002 Honda Civic northbound on Highway 248 when he fell asleep. The car traveled off the roadway and came to rest in a ditch.

Moore was transported to Mercy Hospital in Aurora for serious injuries he sustained in the crash. He was not wearing a seat belt at the time of the crash.

The Civic suffered extensive damage and was towed from the scene by Brice's Towing, of Cassville.

Task Force warrants lead to three charged with meth

The Ozarks Drug Task Force (ODTF) served two search warrants in Purdy last week, leading to charges against three different people for methamphetamine-related offenses.

According to affidavits of probable cause, the ODTF and

the Barry County SWAT team served a search warrant at 403 4th Street in Purdy on Monday, December 19. The residence belonged to Bill Estes Dotson, 27, and his girlfriend, Larinda Mikkelson, who were not home at the time.

Once inside, officers found a baggie of methamphetamine, a glass meth pipe, marijuana grinder with marijuana inside, and various pills, including Diazepam, Oxycodone, Carisoprodol, and Alprazolam.

Upon further search, officers located an additional 8 grams of methamphetamine, several empty bags with residue, pipes and paraphernalia.

Officers then went to George's in Butterfield where Dotson was employed and placed him under arrest.

Officers also served a search warrant at 402 East Highway C in Purdy, belonging to David Saville, 56, who was home at the time the

warrant was served. Officers searched the home, finding six marijuana pipes, empty baggies, digital scale, marijuana grinder, rolling papers, and several more pipes, as well as Carisopridol and Hydrocodone pills, according to the report.

Officers placed Saville under arrest and transported him to the Barry County Jail.

Dotson and Mikkelson were charged with possession of a controlled substance and possession of marijuana. Saville was charged with distribution of a controlled substance and unlawful use of drug paraphernalia.

Mikkelson has not been taken into police custody yet.

tinsel on 30 holiday decorations put up by the city each year. They even rewired a couple of old decorations that were only being used for parts.

Exeter City Clerk Myrna Eisenbraun said, "They did a wonderful job. Even Barry Electric commented when they were putting them that it was the best they had ever seen them looking."

Scott said she suggested the project after noticing the decorations needed some attention. Scott's father also serves on the city council. She stated, "We definitely want to try to do anything we can for the local community to show everybody that our participants do care."

Those involved in the Drug Court program have

to go through an extensive interview process that involves a lengthy application. If selected, they are admitted into the program as a path to rehabilitation to keep them from further trouble with the law. Scott added that the program focuses all of its efforts on treatment and rehabilitation.

Most of the time, community service for participants involves trash pick up and volunteering at various places like animal shelters and food pantries. This project was a change for those involved, and Scott said they really enjoyed being a part of it.

She stated, "They really enjoyed it. It was the most fun they'd had doing community service."

She added, "They really got to show how good they are at certain things. A couple of my clients rewired the lights. It really amazed me to see how good they were or how creative they were with their painting. It just let them showcase their talents."

Eisenbraun said that some community members have noticed the revamping of the decorations and commented about it. "The Merry Christmas sign across the street is the main one people notice," she noted.

Scott said, "The mayor was happy that someone would even offer to do something like that for the city. They don't have as many volunteers and a lot of the city's decorations are hand-me-downs. I've already heard from people talking about how nice it is."

In all, around 15 of the Drug Court's participants helped on the project. Total, they have between 35 and 40 in the program.

Scott said, "It was just so nice to see the decorations no longer look old and tattered." She also said they definitely plan to look for similar projects in the future that will help the community as well as participants in Drug Court.
