# Barry County Sheriff's officer Cosper killed in wreck

The Barry County Sheriff's Department lost an officer to a car wreck last Friday, April 7, around 10:49 a.m. Master Sergeant Deputy Sheriff Carl Cosper, Jr., 56, of Pineville, was killed in the crash with a school bus while on the way to a domestic disturbance in Seligman.

According to the Missouri State Highway Patrol crash report, Cosper was driving southbound in a Sheriff's Department 2016 Ford Explorer on Missouri 37. The school bus, a 2006 Bluebird with the Southwest School District, was eastbound and attempting to turn left and failed to yield to Cosper's patrol vehicle. The bus was driven by William D. Reeves, 60, of Seligman.

According to a witness who asked not to be identified, Cosper was ejected from the vehicle and CPR was attempted roadside. Cosper was pronounced deceased by Dr. Cox at Mercy Hospital in Cassville at 12:09 p.m. Cosper's death was the 22nd crash fatality for Missouri State Highway Patrol Troop D. According to the report, he was not wearing a seatbelt.

Cosper left behind his wife of 30 years, Angela Cosper; his son, Robert Cosper and wife, Jennifer Kendall, of Neosho; and his mother, Sylvia Ann Cosper, of Pineville. He is

also survived by his brother and sister, as well as many nieces and nephews, family and friends.

Once information related to Cosper's crash was public, the Barry County Sheriff's Department released a statement that they were in mourning. The release stated, "He was a big man with an even bigger heart and will be missed by his law enforcement family. Our prayers are with the Cosper family."

Cosper was a Master Sergeant with the Sheriff's Department with 10 years of duty there. He also was a firearms instructor and well known in the area for his conceal and carry classes.

Cosper also enjoyed mechanical work, his dog, Bubba, and making cedar chests for the Angel Tree Project in Cassville.

As news of Cosper's passing spread, the community and law enforcement stepped up in support, with officers displaying blue or black bands across their badges in honor of Carl, whose watch ended Friday while doing his duty.

Cosper's visitation is today, Wednesday, April 12, from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Ozark Funeral Home in Anderson. Funeral services are on Thursday, April 13, at 1 p.m. at Grace Life Church, also in Anderson.

# Two trucks collide on Highway 37

Two Freightliner trucks, one of the carrying a load of asphalt, collided on Friday, tipping one over with the other on top of it on Highway 37 just outside of Cassville in the morning on April 7. According to Missouri State Highway Patrol Trooper T. Coffey, the truck full of asphalt was turning left onto Tudor from Highfailed to yield.

Coffey reported that Teddy Wright, 66, of Garfield, Ark., was driving southbound in a 2003 Freightliner full of asphalt. Troy Adams, 53, of Waterford, Miss., was driving southbound behind him in a 2007 Freightliner. Adams did not yield to Wright, hitting him and tipping the asphalt truck over. Adams' truck drove up on top of way 37 and the other truck the sideways asphalt truck before the two came to rest

at Tudor and Highway 37, blocking northbound traffic.

Coffey stated that the asphalt truck was totaled while the other truck suffered extensive damage.

Both drivers were wearing seatbelts at the time of the crash, and there were no passengers in the trucks. Neither reported injuries at the time of the crash.

## Three injured in Butterfield crash

A woman and two children from Wheaton were injured in a single vehicle crash near Butterfield. According to the Missouri State Highway Patrol crash report, Heather D. Sherwood, 29, of Wheaton, was driving a 2000 Cadillac eastbound on Route W when she crossed the center line, left the road, struck an embankment and overturned on Friday, April 7, around 7:55 a.m.

The crash injured Sherwood, who was driving, a baby and a four year old,\* about a mile west of Butterfield. The Cadillac was totaled and towed from the scene by Brice's Towing, of Cassville.

Sherwood and both minor children were transported to Cox Hospital in Springfield via ambulance. Sherwood suffered moderate injuries and the two children suffered minor injuries. All three were wearing seat belts and/or were in car seats at the time of the crash.







# MDC encourages safety in turkey season

The Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC) encourages hunters to remember safety while in the woods turkey hunting. Regular spring turkey hunting season begins April 17 and runs through May 7. Shooting hours are from a half hour before sunrise to 1 p.m.

MDC Protection Field Chief Randy Doman stresses that the most common cause of a turkey hunting incident is a hunter being mistaken for game.

"Each year, most turkey hunting incidents involve hunters who shoot at sound, color, or movement," Doman said. "It's very important to always identify your target and know what's beyond it before aiming the gun at it and squeezing the trigger."

The popular fad of fanning turkeys is catching on and could be dangerous. The fanning technique involves someone hiding behind a turkey fan and moving it around to attract other turkeys.

"The fanning technique is not recommended because you could potentially be mistaken for a gobbler and become a victim of a hunting incident," MDC Hunter Education and Shooting Coordinator Kyle Lairmore said.

Lairmore encourages turkey hunters to wear hunter orange while moving throughout the woods. "Wearing hunter orange lets other hunters know that you're in the area," he said. "It's also important to remember to never carry a harvested turkey in the open. Be sure to cover them with a hunter orange vest or put them in a game bag."

Lairmore added anyone in the woods during turkey hunting season should also wear hunter orange.

"This time of year we also have mushroom hunters, hikers, birders, and others sharing the woods with turkey hunters," he said. "It is a good safety measure for these other outdoor enthusiasts to make themselves clearly visible to hunters."

MDC also offers the following safety tips for spring turkey hunting:

Identify a turkey's head and beard before aiming.

Never shoot at sound or movement. Assume it is another hunter until you can clearly see a turkey's head or beard.

Wear hunter orange when walking through the woods.

Use hunter orange to identify your hunting location.

Wrap a bagged turkey or decoy in hunter orange when transporting it.

Dress defensively. Never wear red, white, blue, or black clothing because it resembles a

Be sure of your target and what lies beyond.

Never follow the sound of a gobbling turkey or attempt to sneak up on turkeys. Always call turkeys to you.

Sit against a large tree or other natural barrier to shield yourself from hunters approaching from the rear.

Shout "STOP" when another hunter approaches. Don't move, wave, whistle, or make turkey calls to get their attention.

Find detailed information on harvest limits, allowed hunting methods, hunter education requirements, permits, MDC hunting areas, tagging and checking procedures, regulations and more in MDC's 2017 Spring Turkey Hunting Regulations and Information booklet available from MDC offices and nature centers, other places where permits are sold, and online at http://on.mo. gov/2mn9d8K. # **Spring turkey** numbers released by MDC

According to preliminary data from the Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC), young turkey hunters harvested 4,060 birds during the 2017 spring youth season, April 8 and 9. Top harvest counties were Franklin with 118 birds harvested, Callaway with 91, and Gasconade with 87.

Young hunters checked 4,167 turkeys during last year's youth weekend. Barry County hunters checked 13 turkeys total: 10 adult gobblers, two juvenile gobblers and one bearded hen.

# Wildcrafting: Healthy and economical

Spring greens from the woods can add nutrition and flavor to your diet.

March begins wildcrafting season, when greens from "nature's salad bowl" are tender and tasty, said University of Missouri Extension horticulturist David Trinklein.

Wildcrafting, the gathering of plants from the natural or "wild" habitat, is a throwback to our early ancestors who were hunters and gatherers. Their winter diets lacked the diversity of fresh produce enjoyed today. Therefore, when spring arrived, they combed the woods for wild edibles to add flavor and nutrition to their meals.

Trinklein cautions new wildcrafters to study plant identities before they begin. "The cardinal rule to remember when hunting wild greens is to be certain to know what you are gathering," he said. "If in doubt about the identity of a plant, definitely pass it by."

Trinklein recommends the Missouri Department of Conservation's book "Missouri Wildflowers" by Edgar Dennison as a reference to identify plants. He added that beginners benefit from going with seasoned wildcrafters until they learn what plants can be eaten safely.

Avoid roadside hunting, Trinklein said. Roadside plants may contain residue from vehicle exhaust or pesticides from adjoining cropland. Wash all plants at least twice after gathering, changing the water each time. Check for insects and debris. Eat small amounts when trying a new plant, he suggests, to avoid possible allergic reactions.

Prepare wildcrafted greens by putting them in a saucepan with a little water and salt. Cook until tender. but do not overcook. Mix bitter plants with sweeter ones. Add pan drippings, vinegar or lemon juice to taste. Drain water before serving. A common "working man's diet" in the past included soup beans, fried potatoes, cornbread, raw onions and wild greens.

Trinklein recommends the following common Missouri plants for wildcraft-

Cutleaf toothwort (also known as crow's foot). This low-growing plant is found in woodlands and

on wooded slopes. It bears five narrow, deeply lobed leaves that look like the toes on the foot of a crow. The leaves are edible, but cutleaf toothwort is prized for its rhizomes. Their spicy, radish-like flavor livens up salads. Some ferment toothwort to sweeten it; others

• Dandelion. Gardeners hate them; wildcrafters love them. Dandelions are rich in vitamin A and iron. Their flavor peaks during March and April. To gather,

cut off the whole crown close to the soil, pluck out the flower stem and sort out any "trash" or debris.

• Lambsquarter. This later-producing green, also known as wild spinach, is high in vitamins and minerals. Its oval- to lance-shaped light green leaves fare well throughout the summer. Pinch off young plants just above the ground and use

the entire plant, or harvest iust the leaves.

• Nettle. Known for its unsocial behavior, stinging nettle is a popular source of springtime fare. It bears egg to oblong-shaped leaves with a heart-like base and toothed, bristly margins. Wear gloves to gather this green. Nettle tastes best in the early spring. It loses its bristly margins when boiled and tastes like spinach.

purse. • Shepherd's Named because of the shape of its seed pods, it springs to life from a prostrate rosette of deeply cut, lance-shaped leaves. It has long been used to pep up the taste of less savory greens like lambsquarter. Use it raw in tossed salads. "Legend has it that old-time raftsmen floated downstream

in great flotillas of logs to gather shepherd's purse from riverbanks because of its pepper-like taste," Trinklein said.

• Watercress. Related to mustard and radish, watercress floats on the surface of ponds, pasture creeks and cold springs. Its bright green leaves taste best April to June. Its pungent taste works well as a salad or meat garnish. Its high ascorbic acid content, along with other vitamins and minerals, made it a favorite

• Wild lettuce. This plant grows in lowland pastures and along stream banks. It becomes bitter after early April, so enjoy it in March and early April. Its smooth, deeply lobed, light-green leaves set it apart. When broken, the leaves produce a sticky, milk-like sap. Eat it raw or as wilted lettuce

• Winter cress. Called "creasies" in days gone by, it grows in fields, gardens and

waste places. It is a superb potherb picked and enjoyed by generations, Trinklein said. Mature winter cress becomes bitter, so gather early in spring.

Trinklein also reminds wildcrafters that pokeweed is not on the list of recommended plants. Relished as "poke salid" in the past, its toxic compounds make it unsafe for consumption.


"It was so cool to experience writing at the collegiate level at my future college," enthused Liz Moore, a newly admitted Bear. "Especially with my friends."






