Sheriff's Department recovers stolen cattle

A Greenfield man has been arrested for a string of cattle thefts in Barry, Lawrence and Dade Counties, according to Barry County Sheriff Mick Epperly. Greg L. DeJager, 35, is being charged with theft of \$500 to \$25,000 in value and animal neglect.

According to a press release from Epperly's office, the investigation began when DeJager reported over 50 head of cattle stolen or missing from a farm he was caring for near Wheelerville. He had been contracted by owners from Nebraska to care for the property and the cattle, and he was being paid per head.

The theft was reported on May 22. When Detective Doug Henry began looking into the claim, he discovered that DeJager was not telling the truth about the theft and began a more intensive investigation. On May 26, the Sheriff's Department executed a search warrant on the property, but DeJager was not present. Det. Henry was assisted by Det. Rob Evenson and Terry Meek on the 800 acre search on Farm Road 2080.

Once on site, the officers found the cattle to be in very poor health and that they were not being properly cared for. While most of the calves were in good health, the adult cows and bulls were emaciated and starving. It is believed that they were not being fed enough. The officers were assisted by a veterinarian, the cattle owners and a variety of cowboys on horseback to remove

Vacant Seligman Walmart to become Harps

The empty Walmart store in Seligman will soon have a new owner and reopen as a grocery store later this year. In a deal made with Walmart, Inc., Harps Food Stores, Inc., has acquired the Seligman former Walmart along with eight other former Walmart Express stores in Arkansas and Missouri, according to a news release.

According to Seligman City Clerk Brian Nichols, Harps representatives came in with plans for a remodel of the location earlier this year. As of right now, they have also reserved the community center from July 9 through July 29 to hold job interviews for the new location.

Nichols said, "They said the store employees will be in the store on August 1, but there is no opening date as far as I know."

The plans Harps submitted to the city involve building an outdoor cooler for storage and changes to what



The Walmart Express in Seligman opened its doors in December 2014, but just over a year later, the chain announced its closure due to a change in business strategy. Since January 28, 2016, the store has been vacant, but Harps Food Stores, Inc., announced they are opening a store in the Seligman location as well as eight other former Walmart Expresses in Arkansas and Missouri.

used to be the pharmacy in Anderson and Noel in Misthe Walmart. The pharmacy area will be expanded and turned into a deli counter. Nichols said that there was no mention of the gas pumps in the plans, so it appears that Harps will maintain the gas station part of the location, as well.

The other former Walmart Express locations that will be converted to Harps stores are

souri and Gravette, Gentry, Prairie Grove, Cedarville, Mansfield and Charleston in Arkansas. Walmart closed 269 Walmart Express stores earlier this year as a move that would be better for the company, according to information Walmart released.

The Walmart Express opened in Seligman in December 2014, but it closed its doors on January 28, 2016. The opening and closing of Walmart impacted the Seligman community with the city seeing a windfall of extra revenue and then a sudden drop again. The recent store closures have raised a lot of ethical questions about Walmart, Inc.'s policy regarding expansion in small towns and the effect on the local community.

RRSP Nature Center burglar sentenced to five years

One of the two men charged with burglarizing the Roaring River Chinquapin Nature Center in January was sentenced to five years in prison. Terry D. Klein, 55, of Green Forest, Ark., was arrested along with Rodney Leon Evans, 44, of Berryville, Ark., less than a month after the burglary.

At the Nature Center, the two men spray painted the windows to prevent people

from seeing in and stole a four-wheeler, chain saw and a large collection of arrowheads on display. The damage to the cases and displays inside was extensive.

Klein and Evans were also charged with stealing a trailer before the burglary to haul the stolen items.

Park Ranger Steve Jabben received a hit on a fingerprint match to Evans, and while they were investigating Evans' property and recovering items, they deemed Klein a suspect, as well. Stolen property was recovered at both residences.

Klein pled guilty to both the trailer theft and the burglary of the Nature Center and received his sentence in mid-May. Evans is still awaiting trial. Evans has a preliminary trial scheduled for Thursday, June 30, at 1 p.m. on both the stolen trailer and burglary charges.


Cassville Intermediate floor demolition complete

It's been a long ordeal after area flooding wreaked havoc on area businesses and homes. Unfortunately, Cassville Schools was not immune to the damage, and six fifth grade classrooms, as well as a nurse's station, have been closed in the intermediate building since the heavy rains December 26 through 28.

The first week in June marked the end of the first phase of the repairs to make the classrooms usable to the district again. As of last week, the demolition aspect of the project is complete, and now the district is waiting for recommendations from two different companies as to the next phase of the project to ensure that flooding doesn't damage the building and uproot the classrooms again.

Cassville R-IV superintendent Dr. Richard Asbill said, "The demolition and removal of the floors in that part of the building from the flood damage is complete. Phase two will be an investigation and engineering to evaluate two parts. One is the damage,

A Cassville man was arrested this week for stealing \$4,300 from his aunt after already being charged with stealing more than \$20,000 worth of property from a residence on Farm Rod 1110 in Cassville last September, according to the Barry County Sheriff's Department. Matt Cox was arrested and charged with burglary in the second degree and stealing. He is

currently being held in the Barry County Jail in lieu of a \$40,000 cash only bond.

According to the affidavit of probable cause by Barry County Sheriff's Detective Rob Evenson, Cox broke into a residence on Farm Road 2160 that was owned by his aunt in September 2015. Inside, Cox allegedly stole \$4,300 in cash.

According to Det. Evenson's report, Cox told some-

Crowder's new high school equivalency program helps community education

Crowder College - Cassville now offers the HiSET for anyone interested in earning a high school equivalency (HSE). The HiSET replaced the GED in 2014 because it is

more cost efficient. Crowder College Adult Education and Literacy (AEL) works closely with other community resources including the Career Center to ensure that students receive more than

just a high school equivalency.

Crowder has worked very hard to get the HiSET test on the Cassville campus. This test is the equivalent of the former GED, which allows anyone to earn their high school equivalency. The new HiSET test is taken on a computer at the Cassville or Neosho campuses and allows students to take one section at time or all five sections at once. This allows students to take control of their own personal learning styles and the freedom to focus on learning the material and passing the test without the stress of having to learn all of the curriculum at once.

Crowder had to jump through several hoops in order to implement this program on the Cassville campus. First, they had to prove they were a secure site with appropriate computer capabilities, a dedicated server and a certified examiner. Then, there was a change in legislature so the process took even longer, and, of course, when dealing with the government, there was an enormous amount of paperwork. Finally, the hard work paid off and now Crowder Campus in Cassville is an official HiSet site.

Crowder College Adult Education and Literacy (AEL) offers free classes to help students prepare for the HiSET test. During orientation, students will be assessed in reading, math and language to determine where they should begin studies. Since the HiSET is taken on the computer, instructions on how to take the test and use the computer are included to ensure students are prepared. These classes are not required but are recommended to ensure success. AEL instructors work closely with each student to help them transition from the HSE to college or

Testing is offered on the Cassville campus once a month on Fridays and Saturdays, and students can sign up online for one and one half hour time slots.

Crowder director Angela Seymour said, "This really makes it easier for people to get their equivalency. They don't have the added expense of driving to Neosho to take the test, which was a big factor for some students."

The cost of the test is \$95, which includes a \$60 base fee in addition to \$7 per each of the five sections. Test takers must pay the \$60 base fee but can choose how many sections they want to take and pay for. Students will have three attempts to take each section, and each retest will be \$7 with a one year grace period to complete all five sections from the date of registration.

Another plus with HiSET is immediate test results so students know how well they did and whether they need to retake a certain section or if they are ready to move on. However, the written essay takes extra time for grading so the results will not be available right away. Jerri Hudson, test proctor, said, "It is so nice to have the test in Cassville and to have immediate results."

Tests are available Saturday, June 25; Friday, July 22; and Saturday, August 20; and start at 9:30 a.m. Contact Crowder College in Cassville at (417) 847-1706 for more information about HiSet.

Two boys, one boat: A summer of hard work and dedication

Dan Hennis has a vision for the younger generation: a summer filled with hard work, dedication and an opportunity. After spending many years of his life learning to build all manners of boats, cars and motorcycles, he wants to pass that knowledge on to teenagers in the area as a way to build character. It all starts with a simple concept: one boy and one boat.

The original plan was for Hennis to take one boy under his direction and teach him the trade of boat building through helping him build a boat over the summer. The boat will then be sold to help recoup costs. It just so happened that there was a boy from his church who was interested, so he made the offer, and 16 year old Loren Butts, of Cassville, jumped at the chance.

When asked why he wanted to take on the project, Loren said, "So that I can learn for when I get older and I can help other boys, too, because most people don't like to build boats, and I wanted to learn how."

Loren's brother Jerry, 17, also asked to be a part of

the project when he learned what Hennis was offering. So together, Hennis, Loren and Jerry hope to have their boat finished by the first day of school for the 2016-17 semester, and that means a lot of hard work to get there.

Hennis said, "I want them to learn ethics, a trade and have an awesome summer all at once." He added that this gives the boys something to do that makes them work instead of wasting their summer.

He added, "I want to teach youth that there's more to summer than wasting time on playing video games." The program is geared toward disadvantaged boys, but Hennis said he would open the project up to interested girls in the future, as well.

The type of boat the trio

will be constructing is a sea kayak. Hennis said that it is a heritage-type boat. "That means it's a nice boat that you'd pass down to your kids," he stated, and he's already built the same boat on his own.

The difference between the boat they are working on and a standard kayak is that their boat will have a small trolling motor under it to make it an easy cruise out on the water.

Hennis said, "I was raised around building boats, cars and motorcycles. It seems natural for me to build a toy I want to play with. It's hard for me to go buy something like that. But that's what I want to teach them. They don't need a Nintendo or something like that."

While the construction itself will be a feat, Hen-

nis said that since the boys will be selling the boat at the end of the summer, it's an added aspect of challenge. "The hardest part will be to sell it. They'll get to ride in it once to be sure it floats. Then, they can guarantee that it floats to the person who buys it," he said.

Jerry hopes to use the experience with Hennis and his brother to jump start a possible future career. He said, "I decided to do this so I can learn for the future. I want to open my own business someday to do boats. I like being out on the lake and going fishing."

The boys began their boat building journey this week. Hennis began teaching them how to read plans and basic safety for working in a shop. Once they have a firm grasp on those basics, they'll begin the construction.

Hennis said they are relying on donations to fund the

project through physical materials and financial contributions. He said, "Kyle from T.H. Rogers already donated four sheets of wood for the hull, which we are thankful for. We wanted to be fair and we're giving everybody the chance to help if they want." Hennis added that Loren and Jerry have to go ask for the donations for an added dimension of responsibility for the project. He did the initial

legwork of finding businesses that may be interested, but the boys have to actually ask them.

"They have to ask for their investments to help pay for the project. That will help build self-esteem and ethics on top of the skills they are developing," he explained.

Part of the cost of the plans was donated by the company who supplies them, Glen-L, which helps

with the overall cost.

In all, the project has a hard cost of \$2,500, but selling the boat at the end of the project will mitigate those costs. Any extra funds can help Hennis do the same thing next summer as long as there is interest. "As long as there is interest and a recommendation from their church, they're welcome. The denomination doesn't matter, but I think it's important for them to have that support."

Hennis said, "I did the same thing with my boys, but we built houses. They need to learn to work. That's what this is about."

Walking into the project, both Jerry and Loren have some background that will help them. Both have taken wood tech classes, and Jerry will be doing Votech and construction this fall at

Missouri has one of the more rabid populations of distance runners in the nation. a new level when he created Every weekend, runners from Kansas City to Joplin to St. Louis and many other whistle stop venues in-between take to the streets and trails in races against themselves and each other.

Missouri also has one of the best and most complete set of records for the standard tion a few years back when racing distances, ranging from two to 50 miles.

The USATF has very strict guidelines for accepting and recognizing state records, so strict that many of the best performances are not record eligible.

There are a number of "set in stone" criteria that must be met in order to break or set a new state road racing record.

The course

The race must be run on a certified race course, one that is measured and recorded in accordance with USATF guidelines. The course does not have to be exactly the distance being contested, but it cannot be short.

The lack of certified courses causes some anomalies in the state record books, especially in the single-age records. Some race distances disappear for years at a time until some race director shells out the bucks to design and certify a course for that distance. The most commonly raced distances, and the ones most often held on certified courses, are the 5K, 10K, half marathon, and marathon.

It is tough to find events and certified courses featuring some of the popular distances such as the 2 mile, 5 mile, and 10 mile. For the longest recognized Missouri distances, the 50K and the 50 Mile, there are only two certified races held each year.

The runners

I have never understood why Missouri state records can only be held by Missouri residents. There are a number of times in the state book with an asterisk beside them because they were set by runners who did not reside in Missouri. The official record is recognized as the next best time by a Missouri resident.

Official Missouri state records also must be set within the boundaries of the state. So it is possible that a Missouri runner could set an American record for an event but not be recognized as the state record holder.

Drug testing?

The higher the stakes, the greater the likelihood that a drug test might be required. Breaking the single-age record for 60-year old men in the 15K is probably not going to require a drug test. Breaking the overall state record in the 5k might result in a runner producing a test sample.


Cheating

It is simply beyond me to understand why someone would cheat in a road race. Runners are generally the most honest and sportsmanlike athletes to be found. But there are exceptions. Kip Litton, a dentist from Michigan, had many of his race performances disqualified when it was determined that he had cheated. It is not a good idea to try and cut the course at a

ing to Asbill, the district received two bids, Nabholz and another from R.E. Smith. Both have worked with the district before, and the Nabholz bid for \$139,573 was selected at the April regular board meeting.

While Nabholz was doing the demolition, two other companies were on site doing an evaluation to propose solutions for the reconstruction of the floors and classrooms. Anderson and Paragon Architecture of Springfield will be making proposals regarding the reconstruction phase and what will be most beneficial to the district to prevent future flooding event

Asbill said, "They've been present during phase one and

are taking data, elevations and the soil test results and coming up with possible solutions for us." He said the preliminary information should be complete by mid-June, and then the official documents and plans will be presented at

the July regular board meeting for the board to vote on.

Asbill said, "We have a sort of tentative timeline for the project, but once we get into July, it'll be more defined."

365 head of cattle from the property. The cattle were moved on trucks to another location where they could be held and rehabilitated.

The 365 head were returned to their rightful owners; however, it is believed that around 125 head are still missing, and the officers found at least 40 dead cattle in varying stages of decomposition scattered throughout the acreage, both in open wooded areas and some that had been partially buried by a bulldozer.

Through the investigation, the Sheriff's Department found that DeJager had been advertising online to cattle owners that he could care for their cattle. He charged the owners, but then sold or moved many of the animals and reported them stolen to the owners.

DeJager was taken into custody by the Missouri State Highway Patrol on June 2 for passing a bad check and was being held in the Lawrence County Jail. Now, DeJager's bond is \$10,000 with the additional felony stealing and misdemeanor neglect charges.

Epperly believes that DeJager is the first of multiple arrests that will be made in this case. The people and property involved in DeJager's crime are believed to be spread throughout Barry, Lawrence and Dade Counties, possibly more.



Local group lends support for single moms

Being a parent is one of the toughest jobs a person can have, but that job for single moms is even more harrowing. It can be a bitter, lonely experience where a mother feels pulled in a million different directions, and she is often very lonely in it. A group of women in Washburn is looking to ease that struggle for the women of Barry County.

Every Tuesday evening from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m., a single moms group gets together at the Washburn First Baptist Church. Childcare and a meal are provided, and the moms get together for support and understanding from other women in the same situation.

While the group is sponsored by the church, it was really the vision of one woman to get the group started: church member Amanda Crim. Crim said she decided to pursue the group after being a part of a similar circle in Springfield. "I actually had gone to graduate school as a single mom and was part of the Care group in Springfield, and it really helped. There wasn't anything here like it, and there's really a need."

To start the outreach program, Crim worked with the same people who sponsored the group in Springfield. The

Caring People is an organization that hosts meet ups and offers training for other women who want to start their own in other communities. The Caring People is based in Branson and was created by the Herschends, the same family who owns and operates Silver Dollar City as well as many other Branson attractions. Today, over 60 groups exist worldwide, with that number constantly grow-

Women are trained through a one day workshop, which is what Crim and another woman, Rachel Rose, did to be able to start the Washburn group.

Crim said, "It's hard for single moms to feel understood. Single mommyhood is very busy and stressful, and getting that support from people who understand that is a struggle."

The group has been meeting at the Washburn First Baptist, and it is run by Crim, Rose and another volunteer, Chell Eames. Thus far, there have been five or six people attending, but they anticipate that number to grow.

Church pastor Jim Erwin said, "It's open to everyone in the community, but we have a lot of single moms in our church family. It was really on Amanda's heart to do this.

"We're wholeheartedly behind his. We think it's a great thing for local moms."

The single moms Care group meets each Tuesday evening at the Washburn First Baptist Church at 618 North 2nd Street, Washburn, from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. Childcare and a meal is provided. For additional information call Rachel Rose (479) 721-6676 or the church at (417) 826-
