### Cassville PD steps up to supplement school safety

The Cassville Police Department will be supplementing at Cassville Schools in the upcoming school year to ensure that the D.A.R.E. program continues in the middle school. To guarantee this, the Cassville Police Department will be providing an extra officer in the schools to check the buildings while their School Resource Officer (SRO) teaches.

Chief Dana Kammerlohr stated, "The school approached us because they wanted an officer to cover in the buildings when the SRO is doing the D.A.R.E. program. So we made arrangements to make those accommodations."

Cassville Police Officer Jennifer Luckey is the SRO for Cassville Schools. Her duties include walkthroughs of all of the buildings, teaching D.A.R.E to sixth graders each year, and teaching supplemental programs to other grade levels. Officer Luckey is at the school from August through May and also does walkthroughs during the day in the summer, as well. The salary for the SRO position is determined by the City of Cassville and is split 50/50 between Cassville Schools and the City.

According to Melanie Stringer, Cassville Middle School principal, "Our primary concern was that we are very happy with our D.A.R.E. program, but we are also concerned with having a SRO officer available at all times during the day." Stringer explained that, during the eight-week D.A.R.E. course, Officer Luckey teachers students for two hours each afternoon. For the school, that was a significant enough span of time that they were not comfortable not having an officer available for checking into the safety of the buildings.

The solution offered up by the Cassville Police Department was to provide an officer during the times that Luckey is dedicated to educating students. Kammerlohr stated, "The officer assigned will be vary dependent on scheduling. It could be me or any of the officers." While the school has made many security upgrades to the buildings and busses, there is not a substitute for having law enforcement on campus.

Stringer stated, "We are so appreciative of Chief Kammerlohr being so flexible and working with us to ensure we have what we need in our schools for the safety of our students."

Kammerlohr stated, "I'm very glad to see D.A.R.E. staying in the school. It's a very important program. It's not the only one out there, but it encourages a good liaison between the students, officers and school."

Kammerlohr added, "Students need to see the officer as a person who is there to help them in times of need."

Superintendent Richard Asbill stated, "Cassville

R-IV School District has dedicated many efforts to ensuring student safety. The opportunity and partnership with the City of Cassville for the SRO is very important to our security program. In, addition, the SRO develops

good relationships with our students that enable us to not only keep students safe but build value in relationships with our local and county police officers."

#### Perryman sentenced to 30 years in prison

Howard Lee Perryman, the man who pled guilty to four counts of receiving stolen property and one count of tampering, was sentenced in court yesterday to 30 years in prison for his crimes. Perryman, 64, of Monett, was called one of the biggest thieves in southwest Missouri by Barry County Prosecuting Attorney Johnnie Cox. According to court documents, he has over 20 convictions for various offences and also has pending charges in a variety of counties in Missouri stemming from alleged vehicle, tractor and livestock thefts.

On April 29, 2014, Perryman entered guilty pleas to all five charges related to four different tractors and a skid steer stolen in 2010. Jury selection had begun when Perryman entered his plea.

Judge Jack Goodman ac-

cepted Cox's request of at least 30 years imprisonment. Cox stated, "We'd requested at least 30 years because we wanted to make sure he spent the rest of his life in prison."

Goodman sentenced Perryman to 15 years on each of the five charges with three of those charges to run consecutively with the other two charges. According to Cox, Probation and Parole's paperwork states that Perryman will have to serve at least 80 percent of that sentence before being eligible for release.

Perryman still as two cases pending in Barry County from charges in 2013.

# Cassville School Board approves \$4M bonds sale

The Board of Education of the Cassville R-IV School, District of Barry County at a regular meeting on June 12, 2014, approved the sale of \$4,000,000 General Obligation Bond Issue to its Municipal Bond Underwriter, L.J. Hart and Company of St. Louis, Missouri by establishing a final terms committee. "We appreciate the strong vote of confidence we received from local patrons at the election and want to lock in interest rates under current market conditions," stated John Sullivan, President of the Board of Education.

These new money Gener-

al Obligation Bonds were approved by about 65 percent of the voters at the April 8, 2014, election, for the purpose of providing funds for maintenance, repairs, upgrades, renovations, FEMA additions, and improvements including upgrading heating, ventilation and air conditioning and electrical systems at the Primary, Middle, and High schools; installing technology infrastructure and equipment enhancements; completing lighting, seating, and flooring improvements to the Middle and High school

### Fish kill linked to Monett's Tyson plant

Controversy surrounding a chemical dumped into the Monett sewer system is coming to a head after the Missouri Department of Natural Resources released a report on the incident last week.

According to the report written by Sieu T. Dang of the DNS Southwest Regional Office, they were contacted after David Sims, operator of the City of Monett Municipal Water Treatment Facility, reported an issue with the facility.

After investigation, the

source of the issue was reported to be the Monett Tyson plant. According to Tyson, a truck load of ALI-MET, a liquid feed supplement, was taken from the Aurora plant to Monett where the driver told them it was filled with "animal fat." The pretreatment operator at the plant at Monett began dumping the truck before realizing that the load was not animal fat. According to information provided by Tyson, the truck was emptying for five to ten minutes before it was shut down on May 16.

The remaining ALIMET

was treated at the plant with sodium hydroxide to raise the pH as instructed by the City and their chemical supplier, WaterTech, before releasing the rest of the truck.

According to an investigation by DNR and the Missouri Department of Conservation, the chemical spill resulted in a fish kill for at least four miles of Clear Creek downstream of the Wastewater Treatment Facility to Highway 97 in Pierce City.

It is unclear as to whether

gymnasiums; repairing or replacing roofs at the Primary and Middle schools; resurfacing selected parking lots and drives; renovating the old middle school building for future use; and to the extent funds are available, prepay FEMA lease financings.

The district has already begun work on many of the commitments made to the parents, students, teachers, and patrons of the district, commented Becky Henningson. "Priorities were made and our goals to complete several projects before the start of school is important to us. Our efforts to provide excellent facilities and opportunities for our community is our responsibility we take seriously. We have a lot of work to be accomplished and are evaluating all our needs to ensure success," stated Henningson.

The Superintendent of Schools, Richard Asbill, mentioned that he was pleased efforts are going to be made to accommodate local investors. The Board of Education selected the negotiated sale of the bonds in order to capture current market conditions, to be certain that local individual investors and banks receive an opportunity to purchase

the bonds, and because the proposed interest rates will be fair based upon current conditions in the municipal bond market. Dr. Asbill stated that the District will compare proposed interest rates with the national bond indexes and other comparable Missouri issues with a similar rating quality sold at negotiated sales to be certain that rates for the District's bonds are consistent with those being paid by other issuers. The final terms committee consists of the President (John Sullivan) and Treasurer (Jon Horner) of the Board of Education, Dr. Asbill as Superintendent, and Larry J. Hart, President and CEO of L.J. Hart and Company. "By appointing this committee the District can lock in rates during the week of June 16-20, 2014, without needing to call a special meeting as long as the desired parameters are met," Dr. Asbill stated.

According to Kelly E. Liermann, Senior Analyst at L.J. Hart and Company, the serial bonds are scheduled to mature on March 1, 2025,

through March 1, 2029, with reoffered yields ranging from 2.70 percent to 3.20 percent which is consistent with the original projections. Individuals interested in buying some of the bonds are encouraged to contact L.J. Hart and Company at (800) 264-4477 or their local Edward Jones and Company account representative. The interest income from the bonds is exempt from federal and state of Missouri income taxes and the bonds are available in \$5,000 denominations.

These bonds carry a "AA+" rating from Standard and Poor's Corporation due to the District's participation in the State of Missouri Direct Deposit Program coordinated through the Missouri Health and Educational Facilities Authority.

The bonds do contain optional redemption (call) provisions on March 1, 2019, at no penalty that will facilitate the reduction of future interest expense in the event of prepayment or a future refunding to lower rates if

The financing proceeds are expected to be available to the District by July 15, 2014, and will be promptly reinvested by the District to earn additional interest for use in the completion of the projects. The legal documents to complete the issuance of the bonds will be prepared by John W. Brickler, Esq. of Spencer Fane Britt and Browne LLP in its role as bond counsel for the District.

# SWEPCO rehearing to good news for Barry County The Arkansas Public Ser- to take over properties alons

The Arkansas Public Service Commission's (APSC) ruling to grant a rehearing on a massive power line through southern Barry County to serve their Arkansas customer base could mean good news for residents concerned about the power line's impact on their property.

Initially, the APSC approved Southwestern Power Company's (SWEPCO) plan for Route 109 which would have used eminent domain

to take over properties along the southern border of the county. Now that a rehearing has been granted, SWEPCO will have to provide additional evidence on the need for and potential environmental impact of the 345 kV project before they can proceed.

Should the plan progress, SWEPCO will be required to inform property owners of the plans which they have yet to do.



#### Sales tax down for County, City in May

Both Barry County and the City of Cassville experienced a decrease in revenue generated by local sales tax for the month of May according to the figures released by County treasurer Lois Lowe and City Clerk Darelyn Cooper.

For May, the County received \$164,464.51 in sales tax revenue, a \$8,497.56 decrease from 2013 equating to a loss of 4.39 percent. Even with the decrease for the month, the County is still up 8.71 percent over last year's totals partially due to a state-wide audit that netted the County a 46.55 percent increase for the month of April.

So far, the County's revenue stands at \$887,975.08 for the general half-cent tax, \$71,181.09 ahead of last year's to-date figures.

The City of Cassville had comparable losses with a 5.7 percent decrease over May of 2013. This year, May brought \$142,499.56, down from 2013's \$151,130.11. The City is still up 3.0 percent also partially from the statewide audit last month where April had a 27.7 percent increase over last year.

So far, the City has collected \$813,066.27 in the total of all three City taxes that total two cents. Comparatively, in May of 2013, the City had collected \$789,547.11.
