## Crane woman allegedly steals, wrecks two trucks

One woman was arrested related to two separate incidents where vehicles were stolen in the last few weeks. Melissa Ann Hoyt, 38, of Crane, was taken into custody on Thursday, October 22, on two counts of tampering with a motor vehicle in the first degree, burglary in the second degree, theft/stealing and two counts of property damage in the first degree.

The first vehicle was stolen on October 15, around 4:53 p.m.. According to an affidavit of probable cause, Hoyt stole a 2003 Chevrolet 2500 HD truck that was parked behind Johnson Chiropractic on Main Street. Cassville Officer Danny Boyd, of the Cassville Police Department, wrote in the probable cause that Hoyt drove on MO 248 just west of MO 39, where she got into a crash.

Hoyt fled on foot following the crash, but left personal identification behind in the truck.

Then, five days later, Hoyt broke into a garage on MO 248 near Aurora and

stole a 2001 Dodge Ram pickup as well as a pair of gloves and a lighter. The owner of the truck reported seeing her driving the truck the next day, stopped her and spoke with her.

According to the affidavit of probable cause by the Barry County Sheriff's Department, Hoyt agreed to wait for law enforcement, but then got back in the stolen truck and fled, hitting the victim's other truck, a 2007 Dodge 3500 4x4. Damage to both vehicles was more than \$750.

Hoyt is currently being held in the Barry County Jail in lieu of a \$55,000 cash-only bond.

give a donation to be able to wear jeans or tennis shoes for a month or two. This year, they went in a different direction. Employees carved pumpkins that are on display in the Judicial Center lobby, and people can vote for their favorite jack-o'-lantern for a \$1 donation. Circuit Clerk Craig Williams said one of the employees in his office came up with the idea. He said, "Terra Stockton came up with the idea, and I just ran with it." Voting continues in the contest until October 30. At that point, the winner will be determined and will be given a prize.

This year, instead of donating funds raised to a breast cancer patient, they opted to give all of the money raised to Angela Prewitt, a fellow county employee in the Assessor's office. Prewitt was diagnosed with leukemia earlier this year. Williams said, "She's one of our own, so we decided to do this instead. Terra had a great idea and people have had a good time seeing them and voting."

He added, "We're just about raising money for Angela. It's not a lot of money, but it'll help with travel expenses."

This year, pumpkins ranged from traditional to breast cancer awareness to a pumpkin with a striking resemblance to Senator Emory Melton. Voting will go on until October 30.

Williams added that he thinks they will continue the pumpkin carving tradition.

Lester is now traveling and speaking to students all around the country inspiring them to focus on what's important. Lester's motto is, "We weren't born winners, we weren't born losers, we were born choosers." With having to make choices throughout his whole football career that had many consequences, Lester finds this motto extremely helpful.

Lester explained that his main goal is to, "Inspire people to focus on God and not the world. So many people spend their time chasing the world, and they never find peace. I'm just hoping these young people can find their peace at a young age," said Lester.

Lester has received wonderful feedback from traveling and speaking to students all over the U.S. "It's the best thing I have ever done," said Lester.

Lester shared with the students that they can overcome whatever struggles they are facing if they just have faith.

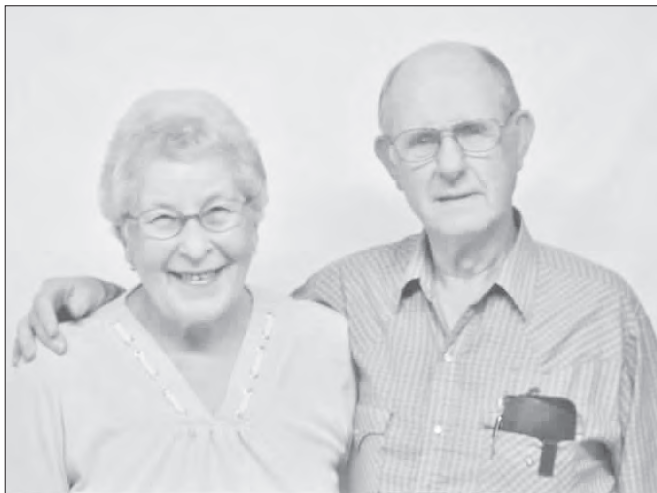

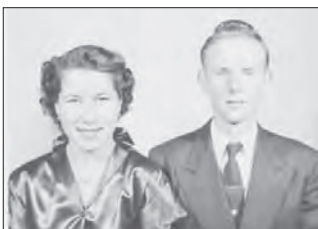

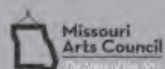

# New option available to keep aging veterans in homes longer



The Horsts have opened their home up to a veteran in need of care after going through a lengthy certification process with the VA.

Golden, their home was approved for fostering about a month ago, and they're waiting for their family newest addition: a veteran.

Foster homes are usually synonymous with children in need of a place to stay, but for our nation's oldest generation, there is also a need for a stable home. Michael and LoAnn Horst's home is the first in Barry County to become certified as a Veterans Affairs Medical Foster Home.

Michael said, "The nice thing about it is that rather than being in an institution, they are still in a home. It's more one on one care." VA Medical Foster homes are a good alternative to veterans moving into an inpatient facility like a nursing home. The closest nursing home to Barry County is in Mt. Vernon. With a foster home, veterans can stay closer to their families and have the care they need.

Michael and LoAnn were approached about becoming a foster home after caring for LoAnn's father, a World War II veteran, in their home for nine years. Eventually, he had to be moved to an inpatient facility due to progressing Alzheimer's but they want to be able to keep sharing their knowledge and caring nature with others.

Some of the benefits that come with staying in a foster home are similar to a nursing home: assistance with daily living, activities, nutritional meals and medication management. However, one huge benefit involves medical care. Any type of routine medical care by a doctor or nurse is done in the home. Veterans do not have to be taken to the VA outpatient clinics in Mt. Vernon or Fayetteville, Ark. Instead, doctors and nurses visit them in their homes for any routine care they need. In addition, the caregivers stay in contact with VA providers to be sure that treatment plans are followed and needs are met.

Michael and LoAnn hope that by getting the word out, a local veteran will find their home as a place of respite.

While a couple of veterans have inquired, they were too far away from Barry County to feel it was the right move. In the Horst's home that overlooks Table Rock Lake, the veteran will have their own room with individual attention from Michael and LoAnn and their son, Joshua. The nine-acre hobby farm also has the added perks of fresh fruit and vegetables, farm-fresh eggs and milk.

Veterans in the VA Medical Foster Homes do pay for their stay, but there are financial benefits available to help pay for their care. For example, veterans who served during times of war qualify for additional assistance.

While their's is the first home in Barry County, the Horsts hope others look into fostering, as well. "We're hoping to reach others that have a heart for caring for veterans," Michael said.

He continued, "I think this is much better than a nursing home. They can stay in a home longer."



game with a drive inside the Mt. Vernon red zone before turning the ball over on downs. But Zane Everett intercepted Garrett Hadlock on the Mountaineers' second snap. Leigh Cox ripped through the line and into the end zone on first down for a 15-yard scoring run and Cassville jumped to a 7-0 lead with 7:18 left in the opening quarter.

That score hung on the scoreboard until late in the half when Mt. Vernon fashioned a 73-yard drive that saw Hadlock score on a 4th-down play from the Cassville 2-yard line. With the score tied at 7-7, momentum had definitely swung.

The Wildcats had only three minutes remaining before halftime. Mt. Vernon had won the coin toss, deferred to start the contest, and were hoping for the slam dunk of scoring the final points of the first half and then starting the second half with possession.

But even with the time constraints, Cassville's offensive coordinator Clay Weldy stuck with the game plan. The Wildcats drove 68 yards on the ground with excellent time-management decisions,

and scored the go-ahead touchdown with just 14 seconds left on the clock. Phelps shot off left tackle and scored from 9 yards out as Cassville claimed a 14-7 halftime lead.

The Wildcats rushed for 193 yards in the first half, winning the war at the line of scrimmage.

Mt. Vernon wasted an opportunity, going three-and-out to start the third quarter. Then the Wildcats drove 80 yards in 7 plays to extend the lead. Cox bulled into the endzone from a yard out, and the score changed to 21-7 midway through the quarter.

The desperate Mountaineers turned the ball over on downs on the next drive, and the Wildcats seemed ready to put the game away. Cassville drove to the Mt. Vernon 25-yard line, but on a 2nd-down play, Shannon Haney was rocked in the backfield. Senior linebacker Clay Eldridge scooped up the loose ball and raced untouched to the end zone as the Mountaineers cut the lead to 21-14.

With momentum turning against Cassville again, River Phelps provided the spark the Wildcats needed.

"Early fourth quarter here at Mt. Vernon. First down at midfield for the Wildcats, Haney takes the snap and feeds Phelps running left. He breaks free, turns the corner, HE IS GONE! TOUCH-DOWN CASSVILLE!"

The Phelps highlight was the first of two Cassville touchdowns in the fourth quarter that sealed the victory. Cox rumbled in for a one-yard score with less than six minutes left after Everett intercepted Hadlock for a second time.

Cassville improved to 5-5 with the victory and extended the current winning streak to three games. The Wildcats will play at top-seeded Reeds Spring on Friday night. The Wolves are 9-1 after shutting out East Newton, 49-0. Reeds Spring has been the top district seed for three consecutive seasons, but has not been able to win the title in that span.

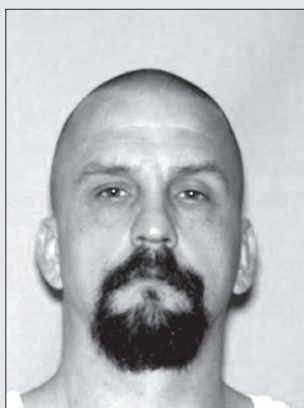
