

## Demolition Derby smashes into town Saturday

This Saturday brings the ever-popular demolition derby, hosted by the Cassville Rotary Club. Each year, the derby brings local drivers and those from afar for a smashing good time at the Bill Hailey Arena in Cassville.

This year marks the 15th year that the local Rotary Club is hosting the smash-up event that draws a big crowd to the same grounds as the annual rodeo.

The categories in this year's derby are modified old iron 1980 and up, stock 1980 and newer and compacts. The event is produced by Grandstand Attractions, Inc.

Admission to the event is \$7 for adults, \$4 for kids ages six to 12 and free for kids under the age of six. Lawn chairs and blankets are welcome, but seating is available on the grounds.

The demolition derby is one of two major events hosted by the Rotary Club each year. The funds raised from the derby and the annual rodeo go to support the mission of Rotary International as well as local endeavors.

Each year, the Rotary Club locally hosts two different programs for area students. One is the Choices program, encouraging students to make good choices in their lives to become successful adults. The other is Don't Meth With Us, which shows kids the dangers of drug use.

The Rotary Club also sponsors foreign exchange students, provides college scholarships and gives third graders at Cassville Schools dictionaries each year.

Rotary International has over 35,000 clubs. Their mission is: promoting peace, fighting disease, providing clean water, sanitation, and hygiene, saving mothers and children, supporting education and growing local economies.

This year's demolition derby will be held at the Bill Hailey Arena in Cassville on Saturday, September 9, beginning at 7 p.m. There will be parking and seating on both the east and west sides of the arena.

## Wheaton FFA collects water for hurricane relief

In only four days, the Wheaton FFA was able to collect 564 cases of water to send to the victims of Hurricane Harvey in Texas. The fundraiser, which was a community-wide effort spearheaded by the student ag group, was a huge success.

Wheaton FFA vice president Rachel Lacey said, "The entire process was eye-opening. The amount of people who answered the call to donate from our little town was God answering prayers."

During the four-day event which ran from August 28 through August 31, the drive resulted in almost every local store being sold out of water. The drive was done in partnership with the Wheaton Family Market and the community at large, making it a wide-spread effort to impact as many victim's lives as they could.

On Thursday, August 31, Wheaton's FFA and volunteers loaded up the cases of water onto a trailer.

Wheaton FFA adviser David Bolton said, "Community member and volunteer Mike Keith drove the truck and trailers of water down to Arkansas and coordinated where it was to be picked up and loaded onto semi trucks and taken to Texas relief efforts."

He added, "The participation cannot be numbered. Countless donors dropped off cases of water and nearly all FFA members had a hand in pulling off such an impactful donation."

Lacey concluded, "It has been such a blessing to watch this come together, all out of the compassion our town has shown for those in need, even though they are hundreds of miles away and people we don't know or will ever meet."

## Naked man charged after soliciting woman in parking lot

A naked man at the Monett Laundry is in custody after approaching a woman and attempting to ask for sex, according to the Monett Police Department.

Carlos Aldaba Rueda, 21, of Monett, is charged with attempted sexual abuse in the first degree, resisting arrest for a felony, and sexual misconduct as a first offense.

According to the affidavits of probable cause, the Monett Police Department was dispatched to the Monett Laundry on East Broadway for a reported naked man trying to get into a woman's car on September 4 at 3:54 a.m. When officers arrived, the suspect, Rueda, fled on foot for about a block until Monett Sergeant Ferguson caught him and placed him in custody.

When officers interviewed the victim, she said that Rueda pulled his SUV into the parking lot behind her car, effectively blocking her in. While she went to her car, Rueda allegedly asked her to show him her breasts, but used a more graphic phrase. The victim told him no and got into her vehicle and locked the door.

At this point, the victim reported that Rueda got out of his car, and she discovered that he was naked from the head to below his waist and began grabbing her car door handle, pulling so hard the car shook. When the victim called the police, Rueda left the scene and pulled his vehicle into an alley across 8th Street.

While speaking to dispatch, the victim said Rueda got back out of his car and stood at the corner of the laundromat, wearing shorts, but holding his penis in his hand.

All of this happened while the victim's 12 year old and six year old daughters were in the vehicle.

Once Rueda was in police custody, officers questioned him about the incident.

Rueda allegedly told officers he had done "something stupid," and thought he had "scared" a girl. Rueda told officers he had been drinking and was approaching the victim because he "wanted sex."

During the interview, Rueda said he did not remember a lot of what happened due to his intoxication, but he did remember walking up to the victim naked. He told officers he was not aware of any children in the vehicle.

Rueda is currently being held in the Barry County Jail in lieu of a \$20,000 cash-only bond.

## Monett man allegedly sexually abuses child

A Monett man is in jail after allegedly sending sexually oriented text messages as well as assaulting a young girl. Matthew Howard Peetz, 55, was taken to jail on August 30, after officers received a report from the victim's mother.

On August 29, Monett Police took a report from a mother who found inappropriate text messages on her daughter's phone, enticing the child to engage in sexual acts with him. The messages, which were reportedly received between August 26 and 28, described a variety of sexual acts he wanted to perform on her and have her perform on him.

When interviewed, the child said Peetz had sexually assaulted her and made her touch his private parts on more than one occasion.

## Cassville R-IV receives exemplary bus maintenance award

The Missouri State Highway Patrol has announced the results from the Motor Vehicle Inspection Division's 2017 annual school bus inspection program and the Cassville fleet has earned outstanding results.

Cassville R-IV has earned the Patrol's Total Fleet Excellence Award by receiving 100 percent approval rating with no buses placed out-of-service. 26 buses were inspected by the Missouri State Highway Patrol.

Upon receiving the report from the Highway Patrol, the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) has awarded Cassville R-IV Transportation Department the Exemplary School Bus Maintenance Award.

"These awards are a reflection of the transportation department, especially the mechanics. Whether going to and from school or riding to an activity, we are committed to using the safest buses possible," stated Dusty Reid, Director of Facilities and Operations.

"Transportation mechanics, Jason Roller and Jake Kloss, take a lot of pride in making sure our students are guaranteed a safe bus. The district wants our patrons to feel comfortable putting their children on one of our buses. Keeping the buses in great shape is just one of the things

Approximately 300 Missouri school districts earned an approval rating of 90% or higher with 258 of those districts receiving 100% approval rating.

"Our mechanics work year around making sure things are repaired and our buses are as safe as they can possibly be. However, on a daily basis, the drivers' complete daily inspections of the buses and report any maintenance needs and these needs are immediately addressed," stated Reid.

cers and admitted that he had texted the child even though he knew he should not have. He allegedly told officers he thought the girl was "12 or 13." He also told officers the child had sent pictures of her private parts which were still on his phone. Peetz denied any sexual contact with the child.

Peetz is charged with statutory sodomy - deviate sexual intercourse with a person under the age of 14, enticement of a child less than 15 years of age, and possession of child pornography as a first offense.

He is currently being held in the Barry County Jail in lieu of a \$50,000 cash-only bond.



# Monett man pleads guilty to child pornography, faces at least 15 years

In the culmination of an investigation by the Southwest Missouri Cybercrimes Task Force, detectives from the Barry County Sheriffs Office and the Monett Police Department, Tom Larson, Acting United States Attorney for the Western District of Missouri, announced that a convicted sex offender in Monett, Mo., pleaded guilty in federal court today to receiving child pornography over the internet.

Carl Donald Greiner, 37, of Monett, pleaded guilty before U.S. District Judge M. Douglas Harpool to the charge contained in a July 20, 2016, federal indictment.

Greiner was convicted of possessing child pornography, sexual misconduct and furnishing pornographic material to a minor in 2004. He was also convicted of statutory rape and two counts of statutory sodomy in 2006.

According to today's plea agreement, a person using Greiner's computer reported to police officers on April 30, 2016, that she saw a large amount of child pornography

on the computer located in his bedroom, including videos of children ranging in age from 4 to 17. Officers executed a search warrant at Greiner's residence the same day and seized his desktop computer along with an address book with internet addresses.

Investigators discovered multiple images and videos of child pornography on Greiner's computer that had been downloaded from the Internet.

Under federal statutes, Greiner is subject to a mandatory minimum sentence of 15 years in federal prison without parole, up to a sentence of 40 years in federal prison without parole. The maximum statutory sentence is prescribed by Congress and is provided here for informational purposes, as the sentencing of the defendant will be determined by the court based on the advisory sentencing guidelines and other statutory factors. A sentencing hearing will be scheduled after the completion of a presentence investigation by the United States Probation Office.



The Cassville Wildcats improved to 2-1 on Friday night at Granby, adding a 45-7 decision to East Newton's ongoing winless season on Friday night. The Wildcats raced to a 26-0 halftime lead enroute to the clock-shortened victory. Anthony Tolbert paced the Wildcats with three scoring runs. For Cassville, it was a tale of two quarterbacks. One played, the other watched. Shannon Haney sat out the contest as a precaution, and his backup, sophomore Deven Bates, turned in a stellar performance while directing the Wildcats on offense. While Haney is a beast in the backfield, Bates is more of an

Alex Smith game manager. The Cassville offense never missed a beat with Bates under center. Bowen Preddy opened the scoring with a nifty 33-yard center screen on a 3rd and 11 play with 7:26 on the first-quarter clock. Drake Reese drilled the PAT for a 7-0 score. # Jenkins Fire receives MDC grant

During July and August, matching funds grant checks for rural fire departments are being distributed by the Missouri Department of Conservation Forestry Division staff. One hundred sixty-nine fire departments are receiving checks for up to \$4,000 to help with the purchase of personal protective gear and fire fighting equipment for wild-fire, as well as structure fire suppression efforts. The total funding awarded to Missouri fire departments through the matching funds grant program this year is \$361,564.30.

Fire departments are required to match 50 percent of the funds which are provided by the Missouri Department of Conservation and the US Forest Service, Volunteer Fire Assistance Program. Throughout the last 30 years, over \$8 million has been distributed to rural fire departments to help them increase the safety of their firefighters and provide them with better fire fighting equipment.
