Thank you for your service, Robert E. Lea!

From being the youngest of 48 charter members of Shell Knob's Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 2203 in Shell Knob 34 years ago, at age 92, Robert E. Lea, of Shell Knob, now finds himself the oldest and the only remaining active charter member of the post.

With a military career that has spanned the globe, Lea finds it difficult to believe that he's been retired from active service for 53 years, not counting the seven additional years he served in the reserves.

"I don't consider myself a WWII vet," Lea said, "although, technically, some people might say I am, since a peace treaty wasn't signed until after I joined the Navy in September of 1946. Fighting ceased a year earlier, though."

Although Lea didn't see

action during World War II, he participated in the Inchon Invasion four years later aboard the U.S.S. Hector during the Korean War.

Lea left high school in Oakdale, California, after his sophomore year and, after working a few agricultural jobs, made his way to his grandmother's farm in Carthage. From there, he and a friend hitchhiked to Joplin, determined to join the military.

"The Navy's recruiting office was the first one we came to, so that's the branch we joined," Lea said.

Following a train ride

from Joplin to Kansas City for physicals and another to San Diego, California, the boys were assigned to different companies for three months of recruit training. Graduation from boot camp marked the last time Lea ever saw his friend.

"From San Diego, I was sent to Great Lakes, Illinois, where I began engineering school," Lea said. "I arrived in January to find knee-deep snow which stayed on the ground most of the winter, and it was colder than I could ever have imagined."

Basic engineering school included the study of lots of

math - which he hated - plus the study of hand-tools and internal combustion engines, including boilers, steam turbines and auxiliary machinery used in a ship's engine room.

Lea's 23 years of active duty with the Navy involved service on four different ships and tours of duty in which he served in various positions, including recruitment officer, company commander, and fleet commander.

When asked, from the perspective of his 92nd year if he would serve in the military

Emergency responders sign “Road Clearance Goal”

Various emergency response agencies and organizations gathered Monday in Jefferson City to sign the Missouri Open Roads Agreement, a first-of-its-kind document that provides guidance to emergency responders clearing incidents from Missouri highways. In the agreement, the agencies adopted a goal to clear traffic incidents safely from the roadway in no more than 90 minutes from the arrival of the first responder. A brief news conference preceded the signing of the document to bring awareness to the dangers emergency responders face, as well as the

Pfizer vaccine approved for ages 5-11

Barry County Health Department administrator, Roger Brock, reports that Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines for children ages five through 11 are expected to be available at the health department sometime next week. The dose for children within that age group is one-third of the dose contained in the vaccination for adults and will be administered in a series of two doses, three weeks apart. The Pfizer vaccine was previously authorized by the FDA to be administered to individuals age 12 and older. According to the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS), boosters vaccines are recommended for adults who received two doses of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID vaccines, six months or more

ago. For individuals who received a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot at 6 months or more after their initial series:

- 65 years and older
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who work or live in high-risk settings

For those who got the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine, booster shots are also recommended by the DHSS for those who are 18 and older and who were vaccinated two or more months ago. Roger Brock advises residents to contact the health department at 417-847-2114 to check for vaccine availability.

Barry County COVID-19 situational update

The Barry County Health Department and Office of Emergency Management report the deaths of three people due to complications of COVID-19 during the one-week period between October 26 and November 2. All three people - two men and one woman - were in the 61+ age category; two had underlying health conditions. The health department reports 29 new cases of COVID-19 for the same one week period, down from 30 new cases from the previous week. The weekly positivity rate is slightly higher, at 6.78 percent, over 5.92 percent for the previous week. The health department reports, as of November 2, that 40.9 percent of Barry County residents have been vaccinated.

Juveniles injured in crash near Exeter

On November 4 at 8 a.m., a male juvenile (17), of Washburn, was eastbound in a 2015 Ford F250 when he lost control of his vehicle, driving off the right side of Highway MM, about a half-mile east of Wayne. The juvenile struck a culvert and a sign, totaling the Ford. The driver was accompanied by a female juvenile (14), also of Washburn, and both individuals were transported by private vehicle to Mercy Hospital in Cassville. Neither were wearing safety devices at the time of the accident. The vehicle was insured with Farm Bureau; the Ford was towed by the owner.

dumps by promoting end-uses for scrap tires. Cassville's project will replace the wood mulch surface at the playground in the Downtown Park with a poured in place recycled rubber tire product to improve safety and accessibility. The engineered surface will provide greater protection for the fall heights of the playground equipment and is superior to wood mulch in many ways: it will not migrate from the site and it is not susceptible to weed intrusion, mold or fungus growth. The firm, stable and

level surface will meet accessibility standards for disabled children and their guardians. From an environmental standpoint the project is expected to re-purpose over 14 tons of Missouri scrap tires. The new rubber surface is expected to be installed in the late spring of 2022. This is the same grant that was obtained in 2018 for the playground next to the Aquatic Center. Leave tree trimming to experts
