

# 100+ Women Who Care hold First Quarter Annual Meeting

The 2024 inaugural round of donations from the local 100+ Women Who Care group has been allocated to the Monett Historical Society. Collaborating with Monett High School's Missouri Literature and Composition class, a GOCAPS strand capstone project, and SRTC's graphic design and construction classes, the museum will unveil 19 new exhibits by May, thanks to the generous contributions. The total donations for this quarter reached \$3,000, with an anticipated matching grant of \$1,500. Additionally, during the meeting, members were treated to a presentation by Monett's all-female Scout Troop 38G, sharing their enriching salt mine camping trip funded by the previous quarter's winning donation.

100+ Women Who Care, Monett & Surrounding Areas, is a philanthropic collective committed to enhancing the community's well-being. Operating neither as a non-profit nor for-profit entity, the group's purpose centers around collective giving to champion local causes. Their mission is to mobilize 100 or more women to donate \$100 or more, four times a year, nurturing a cul-

## What to expect on the 2024 General Municipal Election ballot April 2

Certification was complete on January 23, 2024, for the upcoming General Municipal Election which will be held April 2, 2024. Below is a summary of what to expect on the April ballot, but does not include Special Road Districts, Area School Board Members or Water District Villages due to space. For a complete list or to discuss the upcoming issues or elections on the April 2, 2024, ballot, contact Joyce Ennis at the Barry County Clerk's office.

"The April General Election is the most important election because it deals with the local people's pocketbook," Ennis said. "The General Municipal Election in Barry County has seen the lowest voter turnout with some year's showing less than 15% of registers voters taking part. It is important for our citizens to vote in the General

Municipal Election. I would also like to remind the citizens that absentee voting for the General Municipal Election begins February 20, 2024."

The City of Monett will have an issue on the April ballot for funding for local parks projects. If the issue is passed it will impose a sales tax of one-quarter of one percent (1/4 of 1%) for the purpose of providing funding for local parks projects such as modern playground equipment, permanent bathrooms, and recreational facilities for the City of Monett. The sales tax would replace the parks sales tax of the same amount approved by voters in 2017 which contained a sunset provision.

The City of Monett will also see a mayoral race between Mike Brownsberger and Randy Burke and a four-way race for Commissioner with Al

Dohmen, Ken Gaspar, Darren Indovina and Yesenia Perez running on the ballot.

Monett Fire District will have three candidates, Randy Kristek, Greg Carlin, and Kevin Burnside, vying for two open positions.

The City of Purdy will not have anything on the April ballot as it has an ordinance which states if there is an equal number file for equal open positions the ordinance allows them to not need an election.

Purdy Fire Protection District did not have any-one file so they will have a write-in for one position.

Butterfield Fire Department has an issue on the ballot for additional funding. The issue states "shall the district be authorized to levy an additional tax of not more than 30 cents on 100 dollars on accessed valuation and is to provide funds to continue operation of the district".

The City of Butterfield will see Tony Cope for Mayor, Rusty Dilbeck for East Ward and Russell Lowe for West Ward, all running unopposed.

The City of Wheaton will see East Alderman Brandon Shockley and West Alderman Jeremy Martell, both running unopposed.

The City of Cassville will have a tax renewal issue to continue the capital improvement tax of 1/2 of one percent for the purpose of funding capital improvements including the operation and maintenance of capital improvements which may include the retirement of debt under previ-

# OFO to present young artists concert February 25

The Ozark Festival Orchestra, based in Monett, will continue its 44th season at 3 p.m. on Sunday, February 25, at the Monett High School Performing Arts Center, 1 David Sippy Drive in Monett, presenting its annual Young Artists Concert.

Under the baton of music director Carla Wootton, the OFO welcomes five young musicians playing pieces for soloist and orchestra as part of the OFO's annual Young Artists program, underwritten by the Barry-Lawrence Area United Fund. The soloists will be:

- Cellists Margaret Dodson of Fair Grove, a student of Steuart Pincombe, and Isabelle Suh of Springfield, a student of Stephanie Hunt, playing a movement from a concerto for two cellos by Vivaldi;
- Flutist Luis Campos of Monett, a student of René Spencer, playing a movement from Mozart's Second Flute Concerto;

- Cellist Sam Garrett of Webster Groves, a student of Tara Santiago, playing a piece by English composer Henry Eccles arranged for string orchestra;
- Oboist Elizabeth Snarey of Monett, a student of Wendy Stewart, playing a concert piece by German composer August Klughardt.

The orchestra will also play Shostakovich's rousing "Festive Overture," a march by Czech composer Julius Fucik, a waltz from Tchaikovsky's "Sleeping Beauty" and Leroy Anderson's "Plink, Plank, Plunk" for strings.

The OFO's Young Artists Concert has been offered since 2000. The soloists were selected through auditions by a panel of judges. The Barry-Lawrence Area United Fund helps underwrite the concert as part of its outreach expanding opportunities for young people.

Admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 for senior cit-

izens, and free for children high school age and under. The performing arts center is located on the north side of Monett High School, 1 David Sippy Drive in Monett, west of the Price Cutter supermarket at Bridle Lane and East Cleveland Avenue.

The OFO will continue its season with its next annual Marty Beckwith Memorial Pops in the Park Concert on April 14 at the Monett City Park Casino.

The OFO is a community orchestra composed of players from southwest Missouri and nearby towns, focusing primarily on classical music. The orchestra is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization supported by sponsors, memberships, local foundations, ads in the orchestra program book and funds managed by the Monett Community Foundation.

The Missouri Century Farm program celebrates the lasting contributions farmers and ranchers have made to our country's and state's heritage.

In 1976, the Centennial Farm project was initiated in Missouri, awarding certificates to persons owning

farms that had been in the same family for 100 years or more. Ten years later, the University of Missouri Extension and the MU College of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources created the annual Century Farm program and recognition. Since the program began, more than 8,000 Missouri farms have received the Century Farm designation.

The application period opened February 1, 2024, and will remain open until May 1, 2024. Guidelines used for

the selection and recognition of Missouri Century Farms:

- The same family must have owned the farm for 100 consecutive years or more as of Dec. 31, 2024.
- The line of ownership from the original settler or buyer may be through children, grandchildren, siblings and nephews and nieces, including through marriage or adoption.
- The present farm shall consist of no less than 40 acres of the original land and shall make a financial contribution to the overall farm income.
- Please note that applications will only be available online this year.

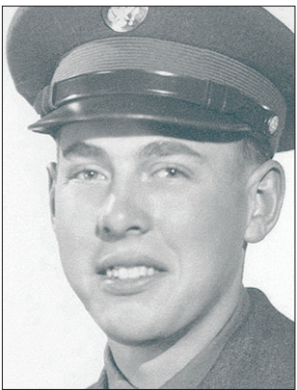

## Beer-Braised Meatballs

Makes 20 meatballs

Ingredients:

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1/2 cup seasoned dry bread crumbs
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1/3 cup finely chopped onion
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- Salt and black pepper
- 1 bottle (12 ounces) light-colored beer, such as a lager
- 1 1/2 cups tomato sauce
- 1 cup ketchup
- 2 tablespoons tomato paste
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar

Instructions:

1. Preheat the oven to 400 F. Line broiler pan with foil; spray rack with nonstick cooking spray.
2. Combine beef, bread crumbs, cheese, eggs, onion, garlic, salt, and pepper in large bowl; stir to blend. Shape mixture into 1-inch balls. Place meatballs on prepared rack. Bake 10 minutes or until browned.
3. Bring beer, tomato sauce, ketchup, tomato paste, and brown sugar to a boil in a Dutch oven. Add meatballs and reduce heat to medium-low. Cover; simmer for 20 to 30 minutes or until meatballs are cooked through, stirring occasionally.

## Crockpot Jalapeno Corn Dip

Ingredients:

- 2 15.25 ounce cans 3 cups whole kernel corn
- 2 jalapenos – seeded and diced
- 1 cup shredded Colby Jack cheese or pepper jack (if you want a kick)
- 3/4 cup sour cream
- 1 8 ounce cream cheese cubed
- 6 slices bacon cooked and chopped
- 1/4 cup cilantro chopped
- 1/4 cup queso fresco
- 1 lime half juiced, half cut into wedges
- Tortilla Chips or Fritos corn chips, etc.
- 2 tsp Tajin seasoning optional

Instructions:

Place the corn, jalapenos, colby jack, sour cream, tajin seasoning (optional) and \*cream cheese in the slow cooker. Turn on low for 2 hours. Stir occasionally. Add the bacon and stir, saving some for the top. Remove and sprinkle with cilantro, queso fresco and a squeeze of lime. Serve with your choice of chips.

\* Notes: You can wait to add the cream cheese until 15 minutes before serving. Add the cream cheese and let it melt. Stir to combine.

## World's Best Oreo Fudge

Makes 48 servings

Ingredients:

- 3 cups white sugar
- 3/4 cup butter
- 3/4 cup evaporated milk
- 2 cups white chocolate chips
- 1 (7 ounce) jar marshmallow creme
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup crumbled chocolate sandwich cookies (such as Oreo)
- 1 cup crushed chocolate sandwich cookies (such as Oreo)

Instructions:

1. Line a 9x13-inch baking dish with parchment paper; set aside.
2. Bring sugar, butter, and evaporated milk to a boil in a heavy-bottomed saucepan, stirring constantly; cook and stir at a boil until mixture is smooth, 3 to 5 minutes.
3. Remove the saucepan from heat. Mix in white chocolate chips and marshmallow creme until melted, then stir in vanilla. Fold in 1/2 cup crumbled cookies until just incorporated. Spread fudge into the prepared baking dish.
4. Sprinkle 1 cup crushed cookies evenly over the top. Press crushed cookies lightly into fudge. Cool at room temperature until set, then cut into small squares to serve.

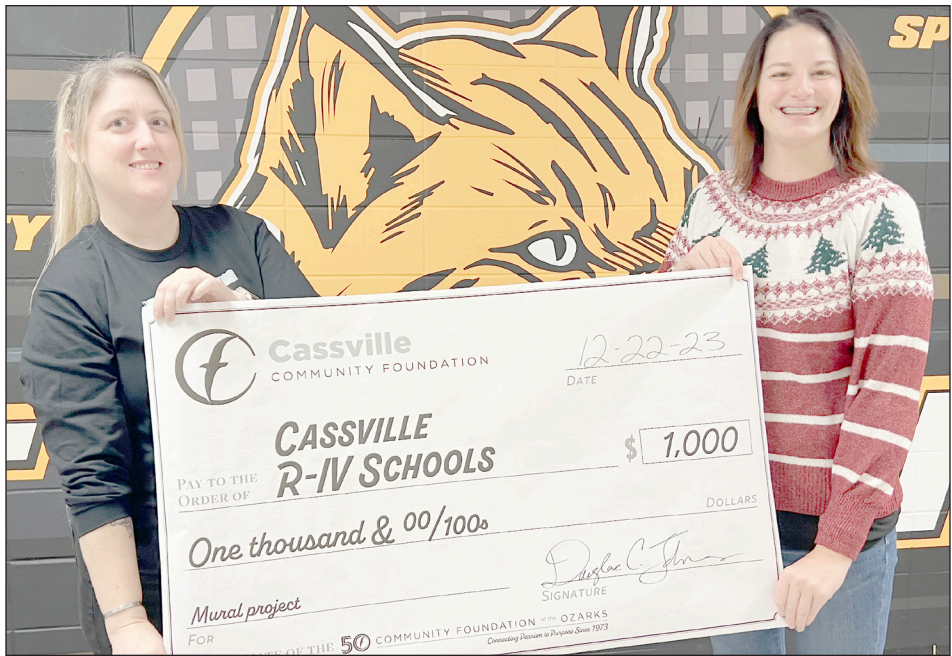
