Council approves purchases in June meeting

In Monday's meeting, the Cassville City Council approved the purchase of a 2014 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, a lease purchase of a Case 580 Super N Wide track backhoe and entered into an enterprise agreement with MDC Technology for \$2,100 each month.

The Cassville Police Department will purchase the 2014 Ford Explorer from Cassville's Les Jacobs Ford for \$26,260, a purchase approved in the 2013 budget. Police Chief Dana Kammerlohr recommended an all-wheel-drive SUV largely because of the area's terrain.

"An Explorer is more serviceable to our department," stated Chief Kammerlohr.

"It is easier to get around in the snow and ice in the winter and during the flooding in the spring. An SUV is easier to transport equipment and evidence. It also has a better resale value than a sedan," the Chief stated.

The City had budgeted \$30,000 towards a new patrol vehicle for 2013.

During the May council meeting, Public Works Director Steve Walensky informed the Board of Aldermen that the Public Works backhoe was broken and not worth repair and created an emergency purchase situation for the department.

After obtaining bids, Walensky recommended a lease purchase from Potter Equipment Company for the Case backhoe for \$78,026. The lease purchase term is for four years with a clause that continuation of the lease purchase is contingent upon annual appropriation of funds for the agreement.

Walensky stated that Public Works will forgo the purchase of a meter truck as previously planned in the 2013 budget.

Finally, the Council agreed to enter into an

enterprise agreement with MDC Technology in Monett to provide service for all of the City's computer, internet, email, website and telephone needs.

As an "al a carte" service, the City of Cassville would be paying \$2,673.92 per month for technology related expenses including telephone, internet and email. According to MDC President Dan Crouch, the City is currently using the most insecure way to send emails and files.

Under the new enterprise agreement with MDC, the telephone system will be set up to run through the internet, eliminating long distance expenses. MDC will also take over the City's website that is currently offline. Before the enterprise agreement, the City was paying \$89 per hour for any changes to the website. The agreement will include unlimited help with the City's website.


Once the website is resurrected, residents will soon be able to pay their water bills online.

MDC will also set up exchange emails for staff where departments will be able to virtually share calendars with each other as well as operate on a much more secure system.

By taking over all of the City of Cassville's technology needs, the City will be paying a reduced price of \$2,100 per month for MDC's complete service. The City was already paying MDC \$1,285 per month just for computer maintenance, a fee that will be eliminated under the new enterprise agreement.

The City will not make the switch to internet based telephones until their current contract ends at the end of 2013. They will have to make a one-time purchase for updated telephone equipment at an estimated \$5,820.

Mercy Hospital Cassville's new helipad ready for landing

The new helicopter landing pad at Mercy Hospital Cassville is complete after nearly four months of construction.

The helipad is easier for hospital personnel to access as opposed to the previous helipad that was located across the street at the top of the hill across from the back of hospital. That helipad was installed 25 years ago.

Hospital president Doug Stroemel stated, "We believe this is a good investment for the community. It represents our continued focus in patient safety which is our utmost concern."

A ribbon cutting will be held Thursday, June 13, at 3:00 p.m. to celebrate the helipad's completion.

Barry County's food insecurity rate shows slight decrease

Feeding America, the nation's largest network of food banks, recently released the results from a 2011 nationwide study that rates food insecurity all the way down to the state and county levels.

Missouri has one of the highest food insecurity rates in the United States at 17.1 percent, which is above the national average of 16.4 percent.

Food insecurity refers to the USDA's measure of lack

food for an active, healthy life for all household members and limited or uncertain availability to nutritionally adequate foods.

Food insecure households are not necessarily food insecure all of the time. Food insecurity may reflect a household's need to make trade-offs between important basic needs, such as housing or medical bills, and purchasing nutritionally adequate foods.

The study showed that

of access, at times, to enough nearly 1,029,030 Missourifood for an active, healthy ans qualified as food inselife for all household mem- cure.

The food insecurity rate for Barry County was listed at 14.1 percent, 5,030 people. Of those 5,030 people, 2,190 of them are children.

Barry County's overall food insecurity rate is lower that both Lawrence and Mc-Donald counties and lower than Barry County's 2010 rate of 15.3 percent.

The study also showed that the average cost of a meal in Barry County is \$2.55 per person, below the national average cost of \$2.67.

According to Feeding American, 57 percent of Barry County's food insecure population qualify for free school meals, 27 percent qualify for reduced price school meals and WIC, and 17 percent rely on a charitable response.

The study showed that overall, many food insecure individuals do not qualify for federal nutrition programs and must rely on charitable food assistance, suggesting that different strategies are necessary to reach food insecure individuals at different income levels.

Klemp-Brattin released from liability in wrongful death suit in McCullough case

One of the defendants in the wrongful death lawsuit brought forth by the daughters of Gary McCullough has been released from liability if she testifies truthfully in the case that is scheduled to get underway next month in Stone County, where it was moved on a change of venue.

In a motion to compel hearing last week, Judge Carr Woods made the ruling releasing Jennifer Klemp-Brattin from the lawsuit.

Brattin was married to Kris Klemp at the time Mc-Cullough went missing 13 years ago.

Klemp had been having an affair with McCullough's wife, Sandra, at the time of McCullough's disappearance. Within days of her husband vanishing, Sandy McCullough moved Klemp into her home. In April of 2000, Sandy McCullough was granted a divorce from Gary McCullough after he failed to show up in court for the divorce proceeding. A month later she married Kristopher Klemp.

In 2006, McCullough's daughters filed the wrongful death lawsuit against Sandy McCullough-Klemp, Kristopher Klemp, Jennifer

Klemp-Brattin and Sandy's daughter, Liehnia "Lena" Chapin, who was reported missing in 2008.

Chapin, who allegedly helped her mother clean up the crime scene after the alleged murder of Gary Mc-Cullough, actually went missing in 2006, but her mother, who had been caring for her son for over two years, did not report her disappearance to authorities.

The case is scheduled to be heard July 15 - 19th.





We plan for this program to be offered in these schools again and hope other area school will participate also.







White River Watershed **National Blueway raises concerns**

The 700-plus-mile White River and its watershed, which includes two national forests and flows through Arkansas and Missouri, was named the second National Blueway river system in the U.S. in January.

This has raised concern with many property owners in Barry County stating as land owners, they were never consulted.

Bill Gracy, of Cassville, gave a presentation last Thursday over the issue.

The White River Watershed affects 21 counties in Missouri including Barry and Stone counties.

According the United States Forest Service. The National Blueways System

is part of the America's Great Outdoors initiative to establish a community-driven conservation and recreation agenda for the 21st century.

A National Blueways System will help coordinate federal, state, and local partners to promote best practices, share information and resources, and encourage active and collaborative stewardship of rivers and their watersheds across the country.

Some Barry Countians believe this is an infringement upon their rights as property owners and want the phrase "community-driven" to be defined since they were never consulted about their land.





USDA offers loans to socially disadvantaged

Farm Service Agency (FSA) Farm Loan Manager Russell D. Neill reminds producers that FSA offers speciallytargeted farm ownership and farm operating loans to Socially Disadvantaged (SDA) applicants. "FSA targets a portion of its loan funds each year to socially disadvantaged and ranchers," said Neill. "Farming and ranching is a capital intensive business and FSA is committed to helping producers start and maintain their agricultural operations.

"In fiscal year 2012, Missouri FSA obligated \$12.8 million in direct and guaranteed loans to socially disadvantaged USDA defines socially disadvantaged applicants as a group whose members have been subjected to racial, ethnic, or gender prejudice because of their identity as members of the group without regard to their individual qualities.

For farm loan program purposes, SDA groups are women, African Americans, Indians American Alaskan Natives, Hispanics and Asians and Pacific Islanders. SDA producers cannot obtain commercial credit from a bank can apply for either FSA direct loans or guaranteed loans.

Direct loans are made applicants by FSA. Guaranteed loans are made by lending institutions who arrange for FSA to guarantee the loan. FSA can guarantee up to 95 percent of the loss of principal and interest on a

The FSA guarantee

Barry County USDA allows lenders to make agricultural credit available to producers who do not meet the lender's normal underwriting criteria. The direct and guaranteed loan program offers two types of loans: farm ownership loans and farm operating loans.

> Farm ownership loan funds may be used to purchase or enlarge a farm or ranch, purchase easements or rights of way needed in the farm's operation, build or improve buildings such as a dwelling or barn, promote soil and water conservation and development and pay closing costs. Farm operating loan funds may be used to purchase livestock, poultry, farm equipment, fertilizer, and other materials necessary to operate a successful farm.

Operating loan funds can also be used for family living expenses, refinancing debts under certain conditions, paying salaries for hired farm laborers, installing or improving water systems for home, livestock, or irrigation use and other similar improvements. Repayment terms for direct operating loans depend on the collateral securing the loan and usually run from one to seven years.

Financing for direct farm ownership loans cannot exceed 40 years. Interest rates for direct loans are set periodically according to the Government's cost of borrowing. Guaranteed loan terms and interest rates are set by the lender.

Barry County designated agricultural natural disaster due to damages from frost

The Secretary Agriculture designated Arkansas counties as primary agricultural natural disaster areas making certain farmers and other agricultural producers in the counties eligible for lowinterest emergency loans from USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA), in addition to other disaster programs.

Two Missouri counties designated were contiguous natural disaster areas due to damages and losses caused by frost and freezing temperatures which occurred April 18, 2013, thru April 22, 2013.

Producers in contiguous counties may also be eligible for programs based on this designation. The contiguous counties are: Barry and McDonald

counties listed above were designated natural disaster areas on

of June 5, 2013, making all qualified farm operators in the designated areas eligible for low interest emergency (EM) loans from USDA's Service Agency (FSA), provided eligibility requirements are met.

Farmers in eligible counties have eight months from the date of the declaration to apply for loans to help cover part of their actual losses.

FSA will consider each loan application on its own merits, taking into account the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

Loans for physical losses must be used to replace or repair damage to buildings, fences or to compensate the farmer for losses of basic livestock, stored crops, or supplies on hand, equipment, etc., that was lost due to the disaster

Loans for production losses may also be used to buy feed, seed, fertilizer, livestock or to make payments on real estate or chattel debts.

Generally, loans for production losses cannot be approved until crops have completed their production cycle or have been harvested. In order to qualify, a farmer must have suffered a 30% loss in production or an actual physical loss that was essential to the successful operation of the farm.
