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County Commission backs opposition of National Blueway

Over 100 concerned Barry County citizens filled the benches at the Barry County Courthouse Commissioner's meeting last Thursday. Those attending were there to show their opposition towards the White River Watershed National Blueway.

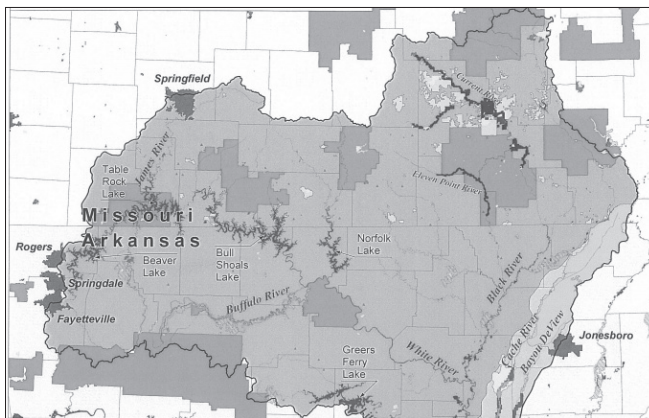
Bill Gracy, a concerned citizen as well as property owner, spoke on behalf of the group to the County Commission expressing fear that Barry County citizen's rights as property owners were being infringed upon through this National Blueway.

The National Blueways System is part of an Obama administration effort to establish a community-driven conservation and recreation agenda. The designation recognizes the partnerships that are working to conserve the river across its watershed.

Gracy stated that those partnerships were not formed by the landowners themselves and many government officials were not aware of the Blueway or even aware of the time frame to show opposition.

"Through this Blueway, the federal government is telling the landowner what is sustainable for their land but landowners were never consulted.

"What won't be considered sustainable will be cattle grazing, tilling, and

fencing," state Gracy.

The Barry County Commissioners and other county officials throughout Missouri and Arkansas are rising up to show their opposition.

Presiding Commissioner Cherry Warren stated, "We don't see how any good can come from this. You are preaching to the choir with us. We are all landowners and don't appreciate anyone telling us what we can and cannot do.

"Believe me, I am all for keeping our waters clean but this Blueway infringes on our rights to use our land for cattle, crops and other sources of farming."

County leaders opposed to the measure say they're worried the national designation could mean limitations for landowners and farmers.

This Blueway affects 21 different counties in Missouri alone and covers 17.8 million acres in Missouri. The National Blueway

would include every inch of land that rainfall runoff eventually draws into the White River.

The federal government does not have jurisdiction over non-navigable waters but those opposing fear this measure will give authority to the federal government over the property owners.

While residents have had since late January 2013 to express their concerns, two weeks ago was the first time residents and state and local officials ever heard of it.

As the clock ticks, counties have until July 6th to show opposition. Many Missourians are meeting with their county officials to sign a resolution stating their county will not acknowledge or adhere to the White River Watershed National Blueway.

The Barry County Commissioners agreed to sign a resolution as a statement of County's opposition.

Felony drug arrest at Sheriff Dept. checkpoint

Saturday night, June 8th, the Barry County Sheriff's Office, in cooperation with the Southwest Missouri DWI Task Force and M.A.D.D., conducted a DWI Checkpoint.

The checkpoint was held on State Highway 37 at the intersection of Route HH south of Purdy. Sgt. Steve Jabben with the Sheriff's Office stated there were 429 contacts made during the checkpoint with three intoxicated drivers taken off of the road.

Jabben also said there were two additional DWI

drug cases worked during the event and one contact resulted in a felony drug arrest.

"This was a very good checkpoint for our county. We had a lot of positive feedback from people passing through and got impaired drivers off of the road," Jabben said. Numerous summonses for Driving While Revoked, Driving While Suspended and Failure to Provide Financial Responsibility were issued during the four hour event.

One Child Safety Seat violation was also issued. Earlier on Saturday, the

Sheriff's Office conducted a Drivers License Checkpoint of Farm Road 1215, south of Jenkins which found one intoxicated driver and two individuals with warrants.

Sheriff Epperly stated, "These checkpoints are a great tool for us to use to get intoxicated drivers off our roads in Barry County. The Sheriff's Office participates in the MODOT State and Community Highway Safety Grant Program which allows us to set up these checkpoints and work with the Task Force."

Barry County daycare has first hearing against State

The halls of the Barry County Judicial Center were lined with supporters this morning (Wednesday) wearing pink shirts saying "Lit'l Bits Proud."

The shirts were worn by many mothers, fathers and former daycare kids to show support for local daycare provider Kellie Dickson.

Dickson went before judge Mark Stephens for an injunction hearing after a petition was filed by the Missouri Department of Health and senior services.

After waiting outside Circuit Division I courtroom, parents quickly filled the seats behind Dickson, then the seats behind those representing the Department of Health and Senior Services and then proceeded to stand during the hearing once seating was full.

Judge Stephens stated, "An injunction relief is ordered for certain actions to be done or not be done on a temporary basis while attempting to prove or disprove something.

"After a lengthy meeting with the attorneys from both parties, I have determined that the State needs to determine what they are going to prove or not prove.

"The State agrees that no children are in immediate danger of bodily harm at the daycare facility."

Judge Stephens stated that the State filed a petition that Lit'l Bits Daycare is not in compliance with Missouri Statue Chapter 210 for not

being a state licensed daycare facility. Judge Stephens also stated that there are no former cases involving this statute to set a precedence for the court to follow.

With that, the judge stated both parties had many legal questions concerning the matter and the Judge still needed to decide what the burden of proof is the State would have to prove or disprove.

Judge Stephens granted the council 60 days to file legal briefs, respond to the legal briefs and present their county arguments all within that 60 days. From there, the judge will make a preliminary ruling on how the statute should be determined, if there should be a jury trial and if should be a half-day trial or a three-day trial.

Once the hearing was over, Dickson's attorney, John Lewright, met with the crowd of supporters and stated, "There is very little guidance provided for this case.

"What will happen is that the State will say that Kellie doesn't meet the standards of state licensing because she hasn't taken their courses. We will need to prove that Kellie provides substantial compliance and is a great daycare provider to our children. Also, that parents are the ones that should decide what is right for their kids."

Judge Stephens stated this case may not have a hearing of merit for another six months.

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Construction begins on new McDonald's

Construction began on Main Street this week after an electric fire consumed the local McDonald's on March 11th. With the renovations starting, the chain restaurant hopes to open it's doors to eager customers soon. The McDonald's fire started approximately at 10:40 a.m. on a Sunday. The fast-food restaurant started to fill with smoke shortly after the transition from breakfast to lunch.

Eventually, the fire was put out and the Missouri State Fire Marshall assessed the fire, finding the cause to be electrical. Cassville's McDonald's is owned by Bill and Walter Mathews of Springdale, Ark., and the two owners previously finished updating and renovating the restaurant in the past several months. The familiar golden arches first appeared in Cassville on August 15, 1996, for the ground breaking of the

new McDonald's on 93 Main Street. The owners of this restaurant chain at the time were Chuck and Leva (Swafford) Peterson. This McDonald's was 4,500 square feet and seated 100. The construction was estimated to take 90 days, and the grand opening of this fast-food chain was on November 27, 1996. Plue Construction of Florissant served as general contractor. The construction supervisor was Steve Schierman and subcontractors were from the local area. Schierman and Gary Jackson, superintendent for Couch Excavating of Cassville, also worked together for the construction of the Monett McDonald's.

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To some people, dairy's reputation for contributing to high cholesterol and weight gain is a misconception that's hard to let go of. But dairy's detractors should know the right dairy products enjoyed in moderation can actually be good for your health for a variety of reasons.

Consuming dairy products as part of a nutrient-rich diet is important for individuals of all ages. Dairy products have many nutrients and vitamins essential to good health. Calcium, protein, phosphorus, potassium, and supplemented vitamins A and D are all nutrients the body needs. Calcium, for example, is necessary to build and maintain strong bones.

Osteoporosis, a condition wherein the bones weaken and are more susceptible to injury, can affect anyone, but it is particularly common among women age 50 and older. The National Institutes of Health say as many as half of all women and a quarter of men older than 50 will break

a bone due to osteoporosis. To keep bones strong, health professionals recommend eating a diet rich in calcium and vitamin D -- both of which are found in dairy products.

Eating low-fat dairy products can reduce a person's risk of developing cancer. Studies have shown that populations that eat a high amount of calcium-rich foods have a lower incidence of colorectal cancer. According to child health authority Dr. Sears, calcium controls the multiplication of epithelial cells lining the colon. Fast multiplication of these cells increases a person's risk of developing cancer. The best sources of calcium include bony fish and dairy products like yogurt.

Dairy products, especially milk, are also essential for different health benefits. Drinking milk helps protect the enamel surface of teeth against acidic substances. This helps prevent tooth decay and weakening enamel.

Milk and other dairy products might also help maintain healthy skin.

Dairy also plays a role in digestive health. Consump-

tion of milk products may help in reducing acidity in the stomach. Yogurts with active cultures have been known to promote healthy digestion and alleviate occasional irregularity.

Individuals with lactose intolerance, a food sensitivity where there are inadequate levels of lactase in the body necessary to break down the lactose sugar in dairy products, may avoid dairy foods. However, information from the Wisconsin Milk Marketing Board says that those with a lactose intolerance can still handle at least two cups of milk a day if taken with food and spread throughout the day. Research also indicates that consuming small amounts of lactose-containing foods may improve lactose tolerance over time.

Dairy products, like milk, cheese, yogurt, creams, and even ice cream, can provide much of the daily recommended allowances of vital vitamins and minerals. Low-fat dairy products are important components of a healthy diet.

Residents to address council need to provide week's notice

The City of Cassville has established guidelines for visitors requesting to address the Board of Aldermen. Anyone wishing to address the council must pick up a form from the City Clerk. The completed form must be submitted to the clerk no less than seven days prior to the meeting to be included on that month's agenda.

Cassville City Council meetings are held on the first Monday of the month.

Those who have a complaint or a question about city services are encouraged to first address their complaint or question by talking privately with the appropriate city department or elect-

ed office.

According to the form, comments are limited to five minutes for individuals and three per person for multiple persons speaking on the same subject. A question and answer period is not included in the speaker's time limit.

Comments are to be limited to city business and issues appearing before the city council on that agenda or issues within the Board of Aldermen's control.

No person should use the time to address the board as an opportunity to advertise personal business or as an opportunity to make a personal attack against an elected official or any other person. Members of the Board

and/or the Mayor may ask for clarification or respond to the speaker's comments.

Those wanting to distribute a document, handouts or present a PowerPoint presentation must submit it to City Hall by the close of business on the first Monday of the month.

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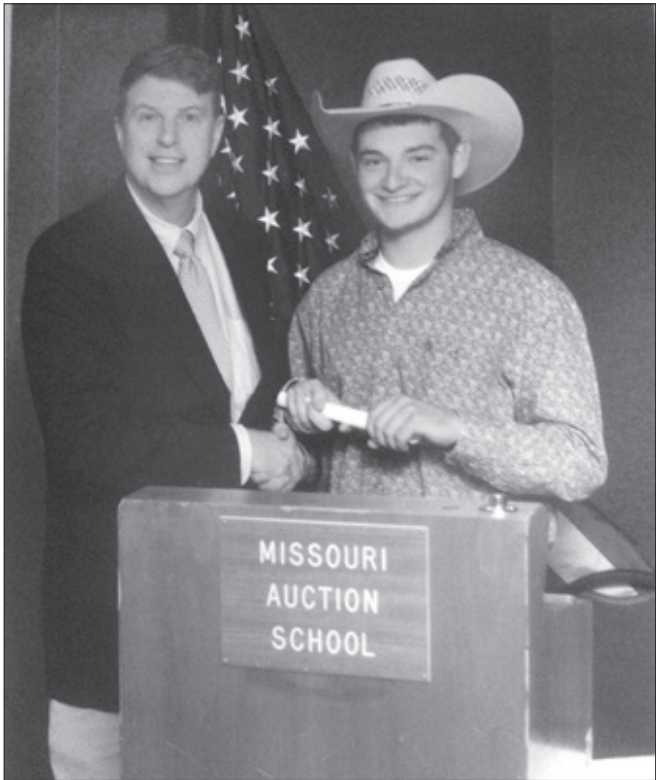

Barry County court hears case on Monett shoplifter

This week in the Barry County Judicial court:

• Joshua Kyle Vermont pleaded guilty this past week in court for robbery in the second degree. On May 13th Officer Brian Brown, with the Monett Police Department, was dispatched to Walmart in Monett regarding a shoplifter. Dispatch advised a male subject had fled Walmart with a detailed description.

Officer Brown took Vermont into custody after finding him in the area of Aaron's Rentals. Officer Brown then went to Walmart to speak to APO Debra Parmley. Ms. Parmley positively identified Vermont as the suspect.

She also claimed to witness Vermont select items throughout the store and conceal them upon his person. He then made his way to the front of the store and past the last point of sale, without paying for merchandise.

Parmley advised Vermont to stop and he then assaulted her by grabbing her by both wrists and pushing her out of his way. Vermont was then transported to the Monett City jail for booking.

He stole two music CD's and two packs of chewing

gum. Vermont received Suspended Execution of Sentence (SES). He was placed under unsupervised probation for two years. If probation is revoked the defendant could receive the original sentence of 6 months confinement in the Barry County Jail.

• Omar Castillo from Wheaton pleaded guilty this past week in court for DWI, Alcohol. Castillo committed the class B misdemeanor of driving while intoxicated on or about January 26th.

Castillo operated a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol. He was also driving while his license was revoked. Castillo received SES unsupervised probation for two years.

If probation is revoked, he will receive his original sentence of confinement in the Barry County Jail for 30 days. He must not violate the law in any manner, consume or possess alcohol/illegal drugs and must pay a fine of \$50.00 plus court costs.

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Highway 39 to Jenkins has been 80 years ago

Following the 1920 Missouri State Highway Department push to develop a statewide system, one of the first state highways through the county was Highway 37 from Monett through Cassville.

After the initial development of the highway system, a movement began about a decade later in the early 1930s for a system of state “farm to market” supplementary roads.

Up to this time, the eastern side of Barry County was served only by the Cassville to Galena state road which today is State Highway 248

(formerly Highway 44). Construction of this highway had been about 1930 and cost less than a half million dollars from Cassville to the eastern Barry County line just east of Wheelerville, a distance of some 24 miles. Contrast that with the cost today which can run 2 million dollars per mile.

In the summer of 1933, a contract for the “farm to market” gravel highway from Aurora to Jenkins had been let and nearly 100 men were working in five-hour daily shifts on the rock right-of-way with a timber crew of 20 cutting trees and brush and a dynamite crew was blasting its way through the rock bluff on the east side of Flat Creek where the road would intersect with what is now 248. A few years ago, the intersection was closed when the Missouri Highway Department rerouted Highway 39 east of the town of Jenkins.

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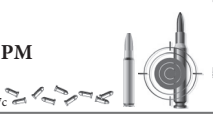

Letter to the Editor...

As was recently reported in our local papers, Secretary of Interior Ken Salazar signed an order in January 2013 declaring the entire White River watershed a National Blueway. This action was done without notification to the governments of the counties affected, without notification of the state representatives, without notification of our federal elected representatives, and without notification of those living in the affected area.

A full definition of a Blueway is lengthy. A short version is that the designation brings various unelected environmental stakeholders and organizations as well as some local, state, federal and international bureaucrats together for environmental issues in the White River watershed. Watershed means every square inch of land from which rainfall runoff eventually draws into the White River.

There is so much to report on this subject that it cannot be included in one letter. However, I will include some sites to look at to fully inform yourselves. Anyone who owns land or lives on it should be outraged at this Federal usurpation of authority.

The Federal government does not have authority over non-navigable waters,

yet this order takes that authority. Any such designation requires a period for public comment, which was not given. Of the listed “stakeholders,” the Missouri Department of Conservation is the only Missouri government entity included. Many others are out of state organizations.

The area included is 17.8 million acres in Missouri and Arkansas. Since the stated goal is restoration and preservation of the river with a comprehensive land, water management plan, the regulation possibilities are endless. The government and non-government agencies have the ability to regulate all surface water, including ponds. This would include rainwater that runs from your land and eventually ends up in the river or water table. Note that the landowners are not “stakeholders”.

Some things listed as unsustainable include cattle grazing, tilling, and fencing. Can we see a problem here?

So, here is what is happening, in both Missouri and Arkansas. Concerned citizens are presenting this information to the County Commissioners in the affected counties and asking them to sign a resolution opposing the Blueway designation.

Fortunately, our Barry

County commissioners have listened and looked into this and are willing to sign a resolution in opposition. Commissioner Warren stated that there is no good to come of this and if it is not stopped, it’s over for us. At this time we know that we have the support of our state Representative, Scott Fitzpatrick, and our state Senator, David Sater. Representative Mike Moon is also working to prevent this designation.

The biggest problem we have is that this was done in such secrecy that we only learned of it a couple of weeks ago and it goes into effect July 6 of this year. We need an immediate, strong outcry from the public to all of our elected officials.

There is a lot of information on prcnews.org. You can also go to the “Secure Arkansas” website for information.

As I said, there is far too much information to put in a letter. I urge everyone to access the listed websites and contact your local, state and federal elected officials. The time is short and this Blueway designation will affect us all.

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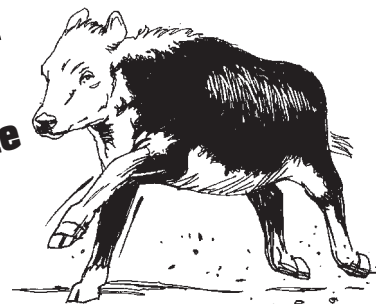

The 4-H standard demonstration is when a youth explains how to do an activity related to their Project Area. Youth prepare demonstrations to share their project area knowledge throughout the year with members of their 4-H club. The overall champion demonstration was given by Savanna Gunter of Purdy, a member of the Exeter Trailblazers 4-H Club.

Project Judging is a 4-H evaluation tool, where a knowledge test is administered and then members are asked to evaluate a class of four items, based on a scenario. The member then gives a verbal explanation of why they ranked the items the way they have, also known

as reasons.

"Project judging is unique to 4-H. This evaluation process not only measures knowledge, but expects students to apply what they have learned through their project work in a real life setting," said Jeremy Elliot-Engel, a 4-H youth specialist with University of Missouri Extension.

The top ten project areas in Missouri are given evaluations at the county competition.

Overall Champion in Foods Project Judging was Erika Bridges of Washburn, a member of Exeter Trailblazers 4-H Club.

Overall Champion in Cake Decorating Project Judging was Maranda Gunter of Purdy, a member of Exeter

Trailblazers 4-H Club.

Overall Champion in Horse Project Judging was Dylan Bridges of Washburn, a member of Exeter Trailblazers 4-H Club.

"I remember when I was in middle school and scared about public speaking. It is great that members are stepping up and sharing what they know now, it will only get easier," said Becky Wogoman, administrative assistant for Barry County MU Extension.

"Our members continue to grow, learn and be successful at all levels of learning and competition," said Elliott-Engel.

Top contestants can now start preparing for competition with the 17 southwest Missouri counties at Regional Achievement Day in July at Springfield.

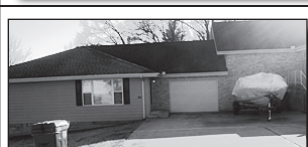
