## Statue shows tribute to CCC program on 80th anniversary

The Civilian Conservation Corps was instrumental during the Great Depression. An estimated 4,000 young men worked in 22 CCC camps in Missouri during that time. The program was geared to provide young, unmarried men employment, a place to stay, as well food.

CCC Company 1713 started work at Roaring River in 1933. From 1933 until 1939, 1,500 CCC boys moved through Camp Smokey at Roaring River.

On Saturday, a ceremony was held to honor those 1,500 CCC boys who were so instrumental in the foundation of Roaring River State Park.

During the ceremony, a statute, dedicated in honor of the 80th anniversary of the work program, was unveiled.

Governor Jay Nixon, who attended the ceremony, stated, "The amount of work

that was accomplished here by Company 1713 is hard to comprehend. Many of the buildings remain and continue to serve as an important part of recreation here at the park.

"During a seven year period, the CCC at Roaring River constructed 33 buildings, carried out 17 acres of beach improvements, landscaped six acres of park and built many miles of roads and trails. Their work also included completing topographical and linear surveys, and building bridges, fire guards, fences, drinking fountains, fish races, garages and the hatchery building."

Also present at the ceremony was Richard Chrisinger, 91, a CCC veteran. He and his daughter, Naomi Shaw, were instrumental in raising funds for the \$24,000 bronze statue now at Roaring River State Park.

## Seligman man violates parole after firearms arrest

Eric Royer, of Seligman, was scheduled to go before Judge Jack Goodman Friday morning for a probation violation hearing.

Royer violated his probation when he was charged with a class C felony of unlawful possession of a concealable firearm on January 6, 2013.

According to a probable cause statement, Royer was in possession of two semi automatic rifles (AK-47 variants, Mak-90 and Romanian WASR) with over 100 rounds of ammunition and four magazines, one pump action shotgun (Mossberg 500) with 54 rounds of 12 gauge ammunition, one Daisy Revolver handgun with six rounds of .45ACP ammunition and one deadly weapon (punch style dagger). At the time of Royer's arrest, Royer was previously convicted of an assault felony.

On September 19, 2009, Royer was charged with two counts class C felony of assault in the second degree and two counts of armed criminal action.

In a probable cause

statement completed by Deputy Lynn Scott, the crime took place in Seligman. Two victims were in Royer's vehicle and rode with him to his residence. Both victims stated that Royer was very intoxicated. When they arrived at the residence and got out of the vehicle, Royer pulled an automatic handgun from under the front seat of his truck.

The probable cause statement goes on to report that Royer pointed the gun at one of the victim's forehead, striking him in the head with the end of the barrel leaving a visible injury. Royer then stated, "Tell me where to find Chris Anderson or I will blow your brains out."

Royer put his finger on the trigger and started to pull and both victims began to run away. Royer fired three shots at the victims, two in the air and one in the ground, almost struck one victim in the leg.

A disposition hearing has been set for May 15th for Royer's charges for unlawful possession of a firearm. He is currently being held in the Barry County Jail.

Decorations left for other holidays such Christmas, Independence Day or Birthdays must also be removed after 3 weeks.
2. No shepherds hooks, banners, lights, figurines or border of any kind are allowed after the three week Memorial Day period.
3. No alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products are allowed at any time.
4. No benches are allowed unless they are placed around a tree.
5. No future planting of trees, shrubs or flowers are allowed.
6. Any decorations that are blown off the graves will be removed and disposed of.

Moore to travel with veterans to England

The Battle of the Atlantic, at its height from mid-1940 through the end of 1943, is often credited as a dominating factor through World War II. Because every effort in Europe depended on the constant arrival of supplies, the Germans made a full-throttle effort to block the shipping routes. In the end the Allies were victorious, but at the cost of 36,200 sailors and 36,000 merchant seamen’s lives. The 8th Army Air Corps, at the loss of thousands of lives, protected England and Europe from the air and ultimately aided in achieving victory in Europe. Sixteen College of the Ozarks students, including Melissa Moore of Butterfield, and seven WWII Veterans that participated in the Battle or 8th U.S. Army Air Corps, will travel to England May 17-28 to commemorate its 70th anniversary.

The Veterans slated to participate include Thomas Easterly (Army Air Corps) of Hot Springs, Ark.; William Ryan (U.S. Merchant Marine and U.S. Army) of Melbourne, Fl.; John Haynes (U.S. Navy) of McCordsville, Ind.; Max Parris (U.S. Army Air Corps) of Kimberling City; Austin Dale Deaver (U.S. Army Air Corps) of Levant, Kan.; Harold Gilbert (U.S. Army Air Corps) of Lewiston, Maine; and Don Elwood (U.S. Merchant Marine and U.S. Navy) of Pendleton, Ind.

The contingent will arrive in Cambridge and visit nearby Parham Airfield, a former 8th Air Force Base. There, they will see re-enactors and British locals who were there during WWII. The group will also visit the Cambridge American Cemetery, where the graves 3,812 American military dead and 5,127 names of missing Americans from the air war over Europe and the Battle of the Atlantic are found. They will also visit London to tour the city, Churchill Museum and the famous Cabinet War Rooms, from where the Prime Minister directed the war effort. In Liverpool, the students and Veterans will take part in the special commemoration activities for the Battle’s 70th anniversary.

These sights and activities will provide the students and the Veterans ample opportunity to reflect and commemorate the longest continuous military campaign in WWII. The students will have a special opportunity to learn from the men who were there to experience it. It is likely that Mr. Easterly will share with the students about

witnessing the 1942 Christmas bombing of London or Mr. Haynes account of being aboard the S.S. Eldena bound to Murmansk, Russia, in the first convoy to feel the full fury of German attacks. The students will also have the unique experience of witnessing American Veterans and Veterans of the Royal Air Force reunite, 70 years after they united to defeat tyranny that threatened the world. In a war speech, Churchill said of the RAF that “never was so much owed by so many to so few.”

“For those of us who did not get to learn from our family members who served, the Veterans who participate in the trips give us a second chance to express gratitude to real, American heroes,” said Matthew Matney, College of the Ozarks junior and trip participant.

This trip is part of the College of the Ozarks Patriotic Education Travel

Program, wherein students travel with Veterans to their fields of battle in order to learn about history and sacrifice from the men and women who lived it. During the trips, students thoroughly document the Veterans’ stories through photography, voice recorders, personal journals and a group blog. ## CORN FIELD CHALLENGES

Already, black cutworms have been seen in some southwest Missouri corn fields.

“Right now the biggest concern in a late planting date for corn is the possibility of black cutworm feeding. Planting delayed because of cold weather can cause concern for high levels of cutworm feeding,” said Scheidt.

Black cutworms clip the corn plants off below or above soil level. If the corn plant is cut off at soil level, the growing point may have been damaged and corn may not be able to recover.

If 2-3 percent of plants are damaged at or below soil level, or if 6-8 percent of plants are damaged above soil level, an insecticide is justified according to Scheidt. A medium rate of Mustang Max or Warrior II is recommended.

“The planting date is not as big of a concern right now in corn. This year’s planting date should not be compared to last year’s average planting which was 10 days ahead of normal,” said Scheidt.

About 15 percent of the corn acreage in Missouri has been planted, that is about 15 days behind normal.

“If you are thinking about switching from corn to soybeans, costs and benefits of switching may not prove wise until planting is delayed until the last week of May,” said Scheidt. “If corn is planted, do not switch to a shorter maturity date variety.”

Scheidt says maturity levels in corn will move faster with increasing temperatures. Switching to an earlier maturing variety may result in corn pollinating too soon in the season.


“Cold weather should not damage corn because the growing point is still protected. When corn reaches 12 inches, a concern for frost damage may be possible,” said Scheidt.
