



The water is in great shape, we have had a bit of rain here and there but other than muddying up the river a bit for a short time, it really hasn't hurt a thing.

Water is still running 28 CFS, just like last weeks report, so nothing has really changed much. Still doing very well on dries, beetle, ants, hoppers, cracklebacks and small wooly worms were a all working well this past week.

Not sure what the hatchery has been up to, but the quality of trout the past few weeks has been great. Lots of 15 and 16 inch trout are in the river right now.

Scuds, sow bugs, pheasant tail nymphs, burlaps, and zebra midges are all working well right now. Black, olive, and tan buggers are working well, especially in the mornings. The jig fishing is great right now. White, tan, and yellow in the mornings, and when its overcast. When the sun is shining bright, darker colors are best. Black/yellow, olive/tan, olive, and black have all been good.

Water is still very clear, so use 2 lb moss green line when you can. Stay away from the camo, blue, or white line, the trout will spook, when the water is this clear.

Plastic eggs and worms always a good bet right now. White eggs, pink eggs and the pink, yellow and the mint green worms worked well this week

Spinners (30 minute wonders) work as good as ever. Black, skunk, brown, olive, and sometimes when its over cast out the pink or white can be pretty good.

# Entomologist to speak at Hobbs State Park

Hobbs State Park-Conservation Area will host a free pollinator program on Sunday, June 25, at 2 p.m., at the visitor center, 20201 E. Hwy. 12, Rogers, Arkansas. 

# Mo Department of Ag warns producers about hay scams

The Missouri Department of Agriculture reminds livestock producers to be wary of potential scams involving hay sales.

The Department has received reports from producers who paid for hay upfront through a wire transfer, only to have no hay delivered. Dry conditions across much of Missouri has left pastures short and hay scarce, causing many livestock owners to search for hay from outside sources.

"We encourage livestock producers to use extra caution," said Director of Agriculture Chris Chinn.

"The vast majority of sellers are legitimate and honest. These few bad actors are taking advantage of a serious situation and hay shortage. Make sure the seller is legitimate before you purchase hay or any other products."

The scams are driven primarily through fake accounts on social media. In most instances, the account appears



real and gives no immediate indication of a scam.

Producers are encouraged to keep these tips in mind when looking to purchase

- Purchase from someone you know, if possible.
- If you do not know the seller, ensure the seller is rep-
- When possible, view the hay in person before any exchange of money. Do not rely on photographs on social media.
- Be cautious of any wire money exchange with someone you do not know.

The Missouri Department of Agriculture and MU Extension manage online hay directories, where livestock producers can search for hay made available by other pro-

The MDA directory can be filtered by county or state and is regularly maintained by Department staff.

The MU Extension hay market listing can be filtered by region of Missouri, hay type and bale type.

If you are the victim of a scam involving hay, contact your local authorities.

#### **Ambush Market**

My dog thinks a 100foot section of our morning walk is Ambush Canyon. Two unleashed dogs ran at her barking and scared her a few weeks ago. Now she gives that house the side eye every time we walk past it, even though she's had only one bad experience out of a hundred walks this year. Investors who walked through 2022 are giving the market a side eye too.

The market technically started a new bull market in the last few days when stocks rose 20% above the last bear market low point. But there are no parades or silly string celebrating the achievement because investors, like our pup, remember the ambush not long ago.

That market ambush lasted most of last year but was the worst in October 2022 when stocks were down 25% off their all-time highs and inflation was over 8% (it's less than 5% now, according to ycharts.com.) It was a miserable time to invest, but things are much better now.

The market isn't quite up to its all-time high, but it is 20% above its last low point (YahooFinance), even though everyone says a recession is just ahead. I don't know if the bear market is over or if this is the start of a new bull market. The market is as unpredictable as a toddler who missed naptime. Up market, down market, up market, down market, up market, on and on.

No one can guess how high the up markets will go or how long they will last, and we don't know how low the down markets will go or how long they will stay down. The reality is that a short recession is still likely in the next 6 to 12 months, but it will probably be a pothole in the road and not a ditch.

There will always be upand-down markets to navigate. Long-term investors should have an investment plan built to ride out multiple up-and-down markets over the years. According to Yahoo Finance, historically, stocks have a long-term trend of going up, with a lot of short-term downturns along the way.

Our twelve-year-old dog had a victory this morning. Usually, as we pass by the "ambush canyon," she walks quickly, continually looking over her shoulder at the scary house. But this morning, she stopped, stared at the house, and peed in its yard, leaving her mark. That's dog speak

for "you don't scare me anymore." Investors need to get to the same point where they can get over the emotions of a down market and enjoy the up markets more. I'm not saying go mark your spot in your financial advisor's office but get to a place where you can tell the market, "You don't scare me anymore."



Health Insurance Options After a Spouse Retires

Dear Savvy Senior,

My 63-year-old wife, who's doesn't work, is on my health insurance plan through my employer. When I retire next month and go on Medicare, what are our options for getting her health coverage until she turns 65? Is there some kind of Medicare coverage for dependent spouses?

Need Insurance Dear Need,

Unfortunately, Medicare does not provide family coverage to younger spouses or dependent children when you qualify for Medicare. Nobody can obtain Medicare benefits before age 65, unless eligible at a younger age because of disability. With that said, here are your best options for covering your wife.

Affordable Care Act: In most cases, your best choice is to get your wife an individual health insurance policy through the Affordable Care Act (ACA) health insurance Marketplace (a.k.a. Obamacare). The Marketplace offers comprehensive health coverage, and she won't be denied coverage or charged extra for preexisting health conditions.

And thanks to the American Rescue Plan and Inflation Reduction Act, the Marketplace now provides enhanced subsidies through 2025. If your income falls below the 400 percent poverty level after you retire - anything below \$73,240 for a couple or \$54,360 for a single in 2023 your wife will be eligible for a tax credit that will reduce the amount you'll have to pay for her policy. The Marketplace also ensures that households with incomes above that 400 percent poverty level will not have to pay more than 8.5

COBRA: Another option is the Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (COBRA), which is a federal law that would allow your

wife to remain with your company insurance plan for at least 18 months after you make the switch to Medicare. But not every employer plan is COBRA eligible. Contact your employer benefits administrator to find out if yours is one of them.

You also need to be aware that COBRA is not cheap, requiring you to pay the full monthly premium yourself. But, if you've already met or nearly met your employer plan's deductible or out-ofpocket maximum for the year, and don't want your wife to start over with a new plan; or if you find your employer's health plan to be more affordable than the Marketplace plans, it makes sense for your wife to keep

her current coverage under COBRA.

Short-Term Health Insurance: If you can't find an affordable Marketplace plan and COBRA is too expensive, the next option is shortterm health insurance. These plans, which are not available in every state, are cheaper, bare-bones health plans that provide coverage for one to 12 months and may be renewed for up to three years in some states. But be aware that short-term plans don't comply with the ACA so they can deny sick people coverage, they don't cover preexisting conditions, and they can exclude coverage essentials like prescription drugs.

To find and compare short-term health plans, try sites like eHealthInsurance. com or PivotHealth.com.

Healthcare sharing ministries: One other coverage option you should know about is healthcare sharing ministries (HCSM). These are cost-sharing health plans in which members - who typically share a religious belief - make monthly payments to cover expenses of other members, including themselves.

HCSM's are cheaper than paying full out-of-pocket costs for traditional health insurance but be aware that HCSM's are not health insurance. They don't have to comply with the consumer

protections of the ACA. They can also reject or limit coverage for having pre-existing health issues and can limit how much you'll be reimbursed for your medical

To look for HCSM plans, comparison shop at the three largest providers: Samaritan-Ministries.org, MyChristian-Care.org and Chministries.

# Fireflies illuminate landscapes with summer love

The flickering of fireflies signals the beginning of warm summer nights. Although these common beetles evoke a sense of wonder for many people, they are simply performing a luminescent courtship ritual that has evolved over countless years, says University of Mis-

souri Extension state horticulturist Michele Warmund.

There are about 2,200 known species of fireflies worldwide, with about 125 in North America. The American big dipper firefly (Photinus pyralis) is the most common species in Missouri. Adults of this firefly are about

a half-inch long, have a red plate behind the head with a black spot in the center, a blackish-brown body and wing covers (elytra) outlined in yellow. The last section of the abdomen, which emits a flicker of light, is known as the lantern.

The lantern glows when

an organic substance called luciferin is oxidized in the presence of the luciferase enzyme, resulting in the release of energy as light.

At dusk or during the early evening, male big dipper fireflies display a J-shaped flash about every six seconds while hovering about 2 feet

from the ground to attract mates. Females are usually found in grass or other low-growing vegetation, waiting for an attractive mate. A female will flash back to the hovering male to signal that she will accept him or remain dark if she rejects the male, says Warmund.

The female big dipper firefly lays her eggs, which also glow briefly, on the soil surface. After 18 to 25 days, the eggs hatch, and the larvae, with two light-producing organs, begin feeding on snails, slugs and worms. The larval stage lasts one to two years before the luminescent pupal stage, which lasts only about 9 to 15 days.

Firefly numbers are diminishing in areas where their habitat is shrinking and where light pollution occurs. To preserve fireflies in residential areas, leave a bit of vegetation such as grass clippings or leaf litter in a small area, which will retain moisture and attract fireflies and their potential food sources. Use pesticides only when needed. Limit outdoor lighting when fireflies are active. If needed, use red light bulbs, as this color is less disturbing to fireflies. Then sit back, relax and enjoy their ethereal beauty as they perform their courtship flickering in the night, says Warmund.
