Opening Day to reel in anglers Sunday

This coming Sunday marks one of the most anticipated days of the year for Barry County, Opening Day. Each year, young and old come from all over to celebrate the opening of trout season with a visit to the beautiful Roaring River State Park.

Roaring River is preparing for an influx of 2,500 to 2,600 anglers for trout season's Opening Day this Sunday, according to hatchery manager Paul Spurgeon. Last year's Opening Day fell on a Saturday, but they only had a turn out of around 1,900 due to a big snow storm. This year, Spurgeon says he anticipates better numbers.

Spurgeon stated, "Gas is a lot cheaper this year, and if the weather is halfway decent, we expect a lot more. We think the weather kept a lot of people away last year." If the campsite bookings are any indication, Spurgeon is right. Almost all of the lodging options at the park are booked for opening weekend.

The hatchery staff is busy

spending the week stocking the waters at Roaring River with 8,000 trout, including 100 lunkers that weigh between three and six pounds. Each year, the number of fish stocked depends on figures calculated by hatchery records from previous years.

The Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce will hand out \$50 Cassville cash to those who catch the largest trout in the men's and women's divisions. The winner of the youth division (12 and under) will receive a trophy. Chamber volunteers will also be on site handing out 850 mugs of free coffee.

Each year on Opening Day, the season opens with the shooting of a gun by a person chosen for their dedication and presence at Roaring River. This year, Tim Homesley, owner of Tim's Fly Shop, will do the honors.

Homesley has a rich history with Roaring River and was born and raised in the area. Aside from owning and operating Tim's Fly Shop where he ties flies himself, he also is an avid fisherman and guide. It was the deep

Mason's minor son also charged in beating of teen

A minor has also been charged in the severe beating of a 17-year-old earlier this month. According to Barry County Sheriff Mick Epperly, the 16-year-old son of the man accused of the crime, James R. Mason, has also been charged in connection with the crime.

Mason, 42, of Cassville, was arrested shortly after Tyler Pendergraft told authorities that he had been lured onto Mason's property to cut wood. After he arrived, Mason lifted the teen's truck with a skid steer so that he couldn't leave the property and then beat him with an axe handle, according to the affidavit of probable cause. Mason claimed that the teen had been stealing diesel from his farm tanks.

The incident, which occurred on February 9, left the teen with serious injuries that required emergency surgery.

Epperly said that Mason's son is being charged with first degree assault for his participating in the beating that left Pendergraft with two broken legs and a bro-

ken nose. He also said that the teen had no prior history with law enforcement as far as he knows.

Mason's son was taken into police custody after he turned himself in by the urging of his attorney in Pineville on February 13. The minor was taken into custody of the Division of Youth Services in their juvenile detention unit in Fair Grove, but he has since been placed with someone outside of that facility, according to Epperly.

Mason was charged with assault in the first degree, armed criminal action and property damage in the first degree. He was held in the Barry County Jail until February 19 when he posted the \$250,000 cash-only bond. Mason's attorney Charles Rhoades filed for a bond reduction, which was denied. The conditions of Mason's bond include having no contact with the victim or his family and he must have electronic monitoring. Mason is to appear in court for a preliminary hearing on May 13 at 11 a.m. in front of Judge Carr Woods.

roots that Homesley has with fishermen of all ages that makes him the perfect candidate this year.

Homesley said he was surprised that he was chosen for the honor. "I haven't really given it much thought,

but I think it's cool. I've been doing this a long time and I've spent a lot of years at the park." According to Spurgeon, Homesley has fished more than 300 days each year over the last 23 years and has been fishing Roar-

ing River for over 30. He also writes a fishing report. In a statement about their decision, Homesley was described as having "knowledge of the stream and trout population that is invaluable to the Missouri Department of Conservation and untold numbers of park users."

When Homesley was asked what some of his fondest memories were at Roaring River, he said he has had so many perfect days on the water that it was hard to choose, but he shared a story about fishing with a friend. He said, "One day we were fishing below the park, and my friend was having a lot of trouble. Finally, he caught a huge brown trout on a fly he had tied himself. It was a 12 or 13 pound fish, and we let it go back into the water. That friend passed away, but it is still one of my best days."

Southwest to build new greenhouse

Due to an increased interest in their greenhouse-oriented classes, Southwest Schools is building a new greenhouse to replace their old one.

Part of the project, which will cost \$73,875, will be paid for by a vocational-technical grant, the remaining \$32,320 was approved to be paid for by the district. The new greenhouse is expected to be completed in May, according to Southwest R-V Superintendent Bob Walker

The main reasoning be-

hind the project was the need to replace the existing greenhouse. Repairing the current greenhouse was going to cost almost as much as building a new one, and the increased energy efficiency will save the district money each month on heat and electricity use.

According to ag teacher Chris Hunt, "The goal of the greenhouse project is to provide a hands-on educational environment for students enrolled in Agriculture Science II, Plant Science and Greenhouse Management. The new greenhouse will al-

low the ability to provide our students to grow their own plants while learning how to manage a greenhouse." The classes Hunt mentioned are geared toward freshman through seniors, depending on the individual course requirements and goals. However, middle school students will also utilize the facility to learn about growing plants, as well.

Hunt continued, "Students will learn the anatomy of plants and conduct research projects on plants, as

well. Students will be able to identify different styles of greenhouses, as well as different types of plants." Other focuses include teaching students how to run a greenhouse, identify diseases and pests.

A variety of vegetables are slated for the new greenhouse, including tomatoes, cucumbers, bell peppers, banana peppers, jalapenos, sweet peppers and lettuce. Other plants, including marigolds, petunias, begonias, geraniums and many others will also be grown. Hunt said, "The students will also learn principles of floral design and construct hanging baskets. The hope is that in late April to early May, the Agriculture Program would have a community plant sale to sell what the students have grown."

According to Walker, the project was bid on by two different companies with the winning bid going to Jamison Construction Company, who does gable-style construction. Walker said the tentative time line is to have the demolition of the old greenhouse begin as soon as possible. In April, the contractor will begin construction and the new greenhouse should be completed in four weeks. By early to mid May, the school's greenhouse should be fully functioning, including the electrical, plumbing, propane and all structural components.

The new greenhosue will be located in the same place that the old greenhouse was which is just west of the ag building at the school.

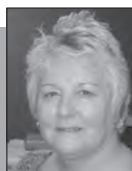

Man in jail after shooting at Aurora home

One man is in custody after firing both a shotgun and a handgun at a residence last week.

Kenneth Jay, 51, Verona, was arrested after Barry County deputies were dispatched to a residence on Farm Road 1190 in Aurora. According to the victim, Jay had fired a gun at the home, causing damage.

Barry County Detective Doug Henry stated in the affidavit of probable cause that there were shotgun blasts and bullet holes in a barrel in front of the residence and the residence itself. In an interview with Henry, Jay admitted to shooting a shotgun and a .357 handgun at the house.

Jay claimed that one of the occupants there had been causing him problems at his home and his place of employment and that he fired the shots to send a message.

Jay was arrested on February 13 and is currently still held in the Barry County

Under the law, you are required to complete training, every five years to renew your license. This will entail attending a group training session. Since 2009, all licensed applicators are required to purchase a Private Pesticide Applicators Training Manual. The cost of this manual is \$15. If you have previously purchased a

Manual (M87) and bring it to the training, you will not be required to purchase another. Your re-certification training session is provided by Extension free of cost.

The 1:30 p.m. session will be held in the courtroom of the Barry County Courthouse (on the public square) on Monday, March, 9. You have the option of attending either this 1:30 to 4 p.m. session or the 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. session, held at the Cassville High School Ag. Building. The program content will be identical with one exception. The Cassville Ag Department will be serving a light meal before the 5:30 p.m. session. Please call if you plan to attend either session so that sufficient materials are available.

“We look forward to seeing you on the 9th of March. If you know of anyone wishing to obtain their private applicator license, please share the above training opportunities,” state Bluel.

If you are not able to attend one of the above sessions, please call the office (417) 847-3161 to make arrangements to ensure no lapse in pesticide application licensure.

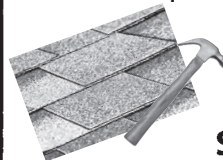

New owners celebrate one year anniversary at 37 Tire

Brad and Melissa Bunnell recently passed a milestone as business owners. January 21, 2015 marked their first anniversary as the owners of 37 Tire and Auto in Purdy. The business offers a wide variety of automotive services, including tire rotations, flat repairs, oil changes, tune ups, battery changing, tire mounting, intake gasket repairs and much more.

Melissa stated, "We carry a full line of tires," she said, "and we can handle almost any mechanical repairs you need."

Customers needing new tires will find 37 Tire has a broad selection for them to choose from as the business carries over 20 different brands. They are also able to sell their tires for prices comparable to wholesale dealers when costs such as delivery, taxes and mounting are fig-

ured in. According to Melissa, customers who buy their tires online from wholesale dealers don't save any money. "They don't take into consideration they'll have to pay a state sales tax and pay for mounting and balance," she said.

Melissa also stated there is another good reason for purchasing tires at 37 Tire and Auto. "If you buy four tires with us, you're going to get free rotation and free flat repair for the life of the tires," she said. "You should rotate your tires more often than most people realize."

Brad handles most of the tire work, including mounting tires on rims, fixing flats and rotations. The only tire service not offered is align-

ments, which they instead schedule through Les Jacobs Ford in Cassville. "They are very reliable and very easy to work with," Melissa said.

About seven months ago, the Bunnells were able to expand the services offered at when they hired Bill Thorson, a mechanic specializing in diesel engines. "Now we

can make repairs on engines like the Ford 7.3 and 6.0s, the Dodge Cummins and the Chevy Duramax," Melissa said. "We can also do more internal engine repairs, such as intake gaskets."

Brad and Melissa don't just limit themselves to cars and trucks, though. They are also able to service tractors and other farming equipment for local farmers. The garage handles an average of 26 repairs a week, excluding the work Brad does on tires, and many of their customers come from Purdy, Wheaton, Monett and Cassville.

37 Tire and Auto has had more than one owner. The business was originally owned by Marty Wolfe, who opened the garage in 1994. He owned 37 Tire and Auto until he retired in 2012 and sold it to Ron and Maxine Gray, of Purdy. In 2014, that couple also decided to retire

and the Bunnells purchased 37 Tire and Auto from them.

As for 37 Tire and Auto's future, Melissa said they hope to expand the business so they can hire at least two more mechanics. "We'd like to offer jobs to mechanics in the area and just serve our community the best we can," she said.

37 Tire and Auto is located at 405 Suite E, State Highway C in Purdy, near the intersection of Highways C and 37. Business hours are from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Tires are installed on Saturdays by appointment only. Call (417) 442-3201 for more information.

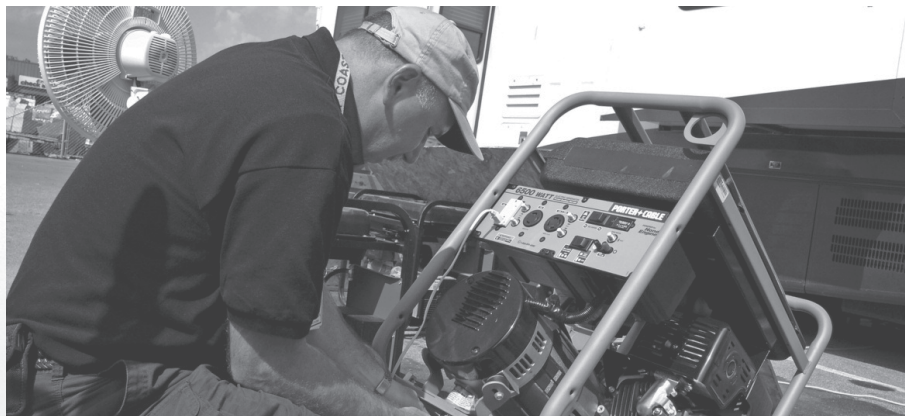
