Above is the newly released diagram of the underground portion of the Roaring River spring. This particular map was designed by Jon Lillestolen, cartographer for KISS Rebreathers, and shows the cave facing east. Lillestolen worked alongside other divers last July when the KISS Rebreathers discovered Roaring River broke the national record for deepest spring. Prior to KISS's expeditions since 2021, the spring had only been explored to 225 feet by divers R. F. Fogarty and R. L. Miller, who first explored the cave in 1979.

As shown above, the cave is predominantly underwater, with an explored length of 2,225 feet, nearly half a mile, and a depth of 472 feet.

The spring is estimated to be larger however, with the diving team's exploration restricted by equipment, time, and other factors.

This depth of 472 feet was discovered last November. Before Roaring River, the record-holding spring was the 462 feet deep Phantom Spring Cave in West Texas.

At 9:00 a.m. and again at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, April 29, the Cassville School FEMA building was the venue for the 5th annual sixth grade class Living Wax Museum, a tradition started by former sixth grade Social Studies and Communication Arts teacher, Ann Nickle. ## Kids Free Fishing Set for May 14

Missouri State Parks and Missouri Department of Conservation will host Kids Free Fishing Day on Saturday, May 14, at Roaring River State Park. Fishing will begin at 6:30 a.m. in the “Kids Fishing Zone”, which will be sectioned off from the first low water bridge up to the hatchery.

Kids Free Fishing Day is free for ages 15 and under. Adults are allowed to assist, which includes casting if the child is unable to do so. A daily tag is required and will be available for free at the big tent, which will be located in

the parking area between the hatchery and Devil’s Kitchen Trail.

Events are scheduled throughout the day, with big tent events beginning at 9 a.m. and will run through 3:30 p.m. Kids craft time will be 9:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. and will be available to the first 100 kids. Kids are encouraged to pick up star stickers at each table to be entered into the prize drawing at 4 p.m. (must be present to win).

Lunch will be served between 11 a.m.-1 p.m. at the CCC Lodge, which will include free hotdogs, chips and

drinks.

The fish weighing station will be available from 7 a.m.-4 p.m. at the big tent. Make sure to stop by the Cassville Area Chamber of Commerce photo booth to document the day’s events.

Bluegrass music will be provided this year by Flying Buzzards, which will take stage at 11 a.m.; Chigger Creek Band, set to start at noon; Sugar Mountain Band will begin at 1 p.m.

Parking will be marked off for the event. Be sure to watch for volunteers with yellow vests.

## Exeter Man Killed in Crash

An Exeter man was killed in a crash west of Exeter Tuesday evening.

According to a crash report by the Missouri Highway Patrol, James Johnson, 37, of Exeter, was westbound in a 2006 Mini Cooper when he slid on the wet roadway and struck Johnathan Lewis, 35, of Stella, in a 2008 Jeep Grand Cherokee on Highway 76, one mile west of Exeter.

Johnson suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at 6:51 p.m. by Barry County Coroner Gary Swearingen on scene. Johnson was transported to Fohn Funeral Home in Cassville.

Lewis suffered moderate injuries and was transported to Mercy Hospital in Joplin.

Johnson and Lewis both were wearing safety devices at the time of the accident.

# Teacher Appreciation Week Celebrated

Expectations for public school teachers across our nation continue to become more and more complex and demanding. Especially the past two years as teachers bravely maneuvered through the uncharted waters of school closures, quarantines, masks, and virtual learning. As demanding as we may feel things have become, little has changed over the years in the level of expectations of our teachers. I ran across a teacher contract from 1923 and it was quite entertaining. Teachers only had to adhere to 13 rules. Keep in mind this was less than 100 years ago. The language of this contract is included below:

*This is an agreement between Miss \_\_\_\_\_ teacher, and the Board of Education of the \_\_\_\_\_ School, \_\_\_\_\_ whereby Miss \_\_\_\_\_ agrees to*

*teach in the \_\_\_\_\_ School for a period of eight months, beginning September 1, 1923. The Board of Education agrees to pay Miss \_\_\_\_\_ the sum of \$75 per month. Miss \_\_\_\_\_ agrees.*

*Not to get married. This contract becomes null and void immediately if the teacher marries.*

*Not to keep company with men.*

*To be at home between the hours of 8pm and 6am unless in attendance at school functions.*

*Not to loiter in downtown ice-cream stores.*

*Not to leave town at any time without the permission of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.*

*Not to smoke cigarettes. This contract becomes null and void immediately if the teacher is found smoking.*

*Not to drink beer, wine*

*or whiskey. This contract becomes null and void immediately if the teacher is found drinking beer, wine or whiskey.*

*Not to ride in a carriage or automobile with any man except her brother or father.*

*Not to dress in bright colors.*

*Not to dye her hair.*

*To wear at least two petticoats.*

*Not to wear dresses more than two inches above the ankle.*

*To keep the schoolroom clean:*

*To sweep the classroom floor at least once daily.*

*To scrub the classroom floor with hot water and soap at least once weekly.*

*To clean the blackboard at least once daily.*

*To start the fire at 7am so the room will be warm at 8am when the children arrive.*

This contract may seem

unrealistic in today's world, but there is much to reflect upon when comparing teachers from 1923 to present day teachers. Patrons within communities have always expected teachers to be upstanding citizens and to model appropriate behaviors to children who look up to them. Teachers do so much more than teach...they are heroes and role models. They make a difference, one child at a time. They bring hope, encouragement, and the ability to dream beyond the four walls of the classroom, transforming the lives of students and the communities in which they live. These responsibilities have stayed constant since 1923 and will continue for many years to come.

This week (May 2-6) is Teacher Appreciation Week. We truly appreciate the meaningful work our teachers

do every day. A school district is only as strong as the good people who dedicate their careers to help mold our students into future productive citizens. The accomplishments of our teachers are celebrated in classrooms all across our district. Every single day, Cassville's teachers are dedicated to the success of each and every child. They provide hope to the most needy young children in our community. They provide stability in attitude and attention to every detail of a child's life and they understand the profound influence they have on the lives of kids.

On behalf of the school board and the community of Cassville, it is my privilege to extend a heartfelt message of gratitude for the work our teachers do. It is true that teaching is a calling, not a profession, and I am so honored that our teachers have

## From the Roots Up - Improving Garden Soil

Greetings Friends!  
We are getting an adequate amount of seasonal rain; as of this writing, there have been dry days interspersed with wet ones, so hopefully, you can get some

gardening time in. Today, we will talk about building up good soil, and plant nutrient needs. If you did a soil sample in the spring, the county extension office sends in the mail to you information about your soil, its PH level,

and its nutrient levels. This can be very helpful in telling you how to amend your soil.  
If you did not get a soil sample this year, it's okay. You can still plant a garden. I would recommend adding compost to your garden.

If you buy it in bags, it is easier to haul home but more expensive. I recommend buying it in bulk from a garden center and hauling it home in a truck or on a trailer. Delivery is often available, but that adds tremendously to the expense. If you are building raised beds, I recommend buying in bulk and mixing half topsoil and half compost. Planting in compost only is not recommended as it does not hold the moisture well enough, and it lacks the nutrients that your vegetables need.

Give the garden center the dimensions of your beds, and they can tell you how much to order. Some garden companies will mix these for you; be sure to ask because not all do. Making raised beds can get expensive, so be prepared for the cost involved; you might call ahead and get a quote. You will only need to order compost if gardening in-ground as the ground is your topsoil. Work the compost into the existing soil before planting.

Aerating the soil increases the oxygen available to aid in good root growth. You

may be wondering, if you use compost, do you need fertilizer as well? The answer is usually yes. If buying from a garden center, ask if the compost has had fertilizer added to it. If using compost you have made from yard and vegetable waste, you would need to add fertilizer. The difference between compost and fertilizer is compost feeds the soil while fertilizer feeds the plant. Compost is a longer process for building up good soil; its nutrients are released more slowly. Fertilizer is quick-acting and needs replenishing often. Its nutrients are released quickly, and you can target specific nutrient needs. I use 13-13-13 fertilizer. It contains 13% of nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium in it.

Nitrogen is for green leaf production to aid in the photosynthesis process. Phosphorus is needed for good root development. Potassium helps plants resist diseases and helps with proper cell division. Apply one-half pound per 25 feet of row, working into the soil before planting. If you are using aged animal manure, fertilizer is not needed.

Dear Savvy Senior,

The process of downsizing and moving to a new home is a big job for anyone, but it can be especially overwhelming for seniors who are moving from a long-time

residence filled with decade’s worth of stuff and a lifetime of memories. Fortunately, there’s a specialized service available today that can help make your mom’s move a lot easier for her, and for you.

**Senior Move Manager**

To help your mom get packed up and moved into her new home, you should consider hiring a “senior move manager.” These are trained organizers (they are not moving companies) who assist older people with the challenges of relocating and can minimize the stress of this major transition by doing most of the work for you.

A senior move manager

can help your mom pare down her belongings, decide what to take and what to dispose of, recommend charities for donations and help sell her unwanted items.

They can even create a customized floor plan of her new home so your mom can visualize where her belongings will fit.

Senior move managers can also get estimates from moving companies, oversee the movers, arrange the move date, supervise the packing and unpacking and help set up her new home, have the house cleaned and just about anything you need related to her move.

If you want to do some of the work yourself, you can pick and choose only the services you want. For example, you may only want a move manager’s help with downsizing and selling excess furniture and unwanted belongings but plan on doing the actual packing and moving yourself. The cost of working with a senior move manager will vary depend-

ing on where you live, the services you want and size of the move, but you can expect to pay somewhere between \$60 and \$125 per hour or more, not including the cost of movers.

**How to Find One**

To locate a senior move manager in your area, visit the National Association of Senior Move Managers website at NASMM.org or call 877-606-2766. The NASMM is a trade association with an accreditation program that requires its members to abide by a strict code of ethics that ensures integrity. They currently have around 1,000 members across the U.S.

You can also search at Caring Transitions (Caring-Transitions.com), which is the largest senior relocation and transition services franchised company in the U.S.

They currently have nearly 200 franchises throughout the country.

But, before you hire one, be sure you ask for references from previous clients and check them, and check with the Better Business Bureau too.

Also, find out how many moves they have actually managed and get a written list of services and fees. And make sure they’re insured

and bonded.


If you can’t find a senior move manager in your area, another option is to hire a certified professional organizer who specializes in downsizing and relocating. To find one, check the National Association of Productivity and Organizing Professionals, which has a searchable database on its website at NAPO.net.
